NOTES TO RIDERS AND HELPERS AND LOCAL REGULATIONS

ROUTE TO START, Right out of HQ, right onto the A134, left onto the A1071, start is 1.1 mls from the HQ.

No warming up by competitors on the course once the event has started, use the A134.

No U Turns are allowed within sight of the start or finishing points. Riders carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre are liable for disqualification from the event and further disciplinary action by the District Committee.

Riders must give way to traffic at roundabouts entering from their right and also to give to clear signal of their intended route

There is no parking allowed in the vicinity of the start or finish

Body numbers will be situated at the event HQ. Exchange for a cup of tea.

Marshals must wear a High Visibility jacket.

There is a Mountain Bike Event starting at 10am being held near the course with access from the A1071 after Hintlesham, please be aware there may be queuing traffic entering the site, the organisers are aware of our event and will endeavour to give you a clear passage.

CAUTION, please be aware of the sharp bends on the approach to Hintlesham, especially so, if it's wet.

Pay special caution at the junction with B1115 on your left after around 6 miles, you will be moving downhill quickly, vehicles emerging from that junction are poorly sighted because of uncut verges.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL SAFETY HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

All juniors and or riders under the age of 19 years are required to wear a suitably approved helmet.

Cycling Time Trials recommend the use of a flashing rear light whilst competing
