COURSE DETAILS E1/25d (10.2m).

START on B1383 10 yards north of the Belcham's Lane leading to Rickling Green which is 0.25m north of Chequers PH. Proceed north through Quendon & Newport, straight on at roundabout junction B1383/B1052, Littlebury, Great Chesterford to Stumps Cross roundabout where turn right onto the onto B184 and continue to Little Chesterbury roundabout (11.75m). U turn at roundabout and retrace to Stumps Cross roundabout. Turn left onto B1383 and retrace along course past start point to FINISH at centre of layby which is just past Pennington Lane and approx. 0.1m N of 32nd MS.

In the interest of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell safety helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. All juniors and/or riders under the age of 19 years are required to wear a suitably approved helmet.

RIDERS BRIEFING NOTICE

Riders waiting to start and officials <u>must stay</u> on grass verge at Start and Finish.

Riders MUST NOT stop at Finish to check their times but continue riding back to HQ.

Riders requested to give appropriate hand signal when approaching and turning at Roundabouts. Riders must give way to traffic from right.

LONDON EAST LOCAL REGULATIONS

1 Competitors are not allowed to warm up on any part of the designated course once the event has started.
2 No 'U' turns are allowed within sight of either the start or finish points. Riders carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre are liable for disqualification from the event and to further disciplinary action by the London East CTT District Committee.

- **3** No parking at either the start or finish points, other than the time keepers car.
- **4** Body numbers will be available at the event headquarters
- **5** Body numbers should be returned after the event and the start sheet signed in the signing-off box. Failure to do this will result in your result being marked as 'DNF'.

All riders should return to the headquarters as drug testing may be in force at this event.

Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoter recommend the use of a flashing rear light whilst competing.

Route to the start

If coming North through Stansted Mountfitchett along B1383, turn right at "Chequers" Pub, Ugley and park as above.
