## Course J4/17 – 10 miles

Start on the B5081 adjacent to a large Oak Tree N/E of the entrance to “Earnshaw House Farm”  
Proceed North Eastwards to Three Greyhounds Public House 0.615 m

Left along the B5082 (Pennys Lane) to Rudheath 3.586 m

Left along the A556 extreme care joining DC to King Street 3.731 m

Left along the A530/B5309 to Centurion Way 7.346 m

Filter Left at the traffic lights along Centurion Way via an un-named traffic island

1st exit left continue along Centurion way to Kinderton 7.903 m

Left on the B5081 to Finish 10.000 m

On the B5081 at the 2nd field gate post at the entrance to a field directly opposite Byley Village Boundary sign.

**Please do your warm ups along the B5081 or Kings Lane, but not on the course.**

### Numbers & Result Board at HQ

HQ is at Goostrey Village Hall, Main Road, Goostrey, Cheshire, CW4 8PE

**(approx. 4 miles from start).**

**DO NOT Park outside of the Village Hall Gates! Unless instructed to do so.**

**To the START from HQ:** turn left along Main Road and Goostrey Lane (same road) all the way to the A50, Knusford Road. Turn RIGHT (WITH CARE) onto A50 and then LEFT onto B5082, Northwich Road, over the Motorway to the Three Greyhounds Pub, then LEFT onto B5081 to the START. **After FINISH retrace to HQ**

**Before Collecting Numbers----All competitors MUST SIGN ----Sign on sheet and**

**SIGN-OFF when returning it, Failure to do so will result in that rider being classified as DNF**

### Local Regulations

No Parking in Start or Finish Areas other than Timekeeper and Officials

#### Care at Junctions

Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross **THE WHITE LINE** when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the district committee for further disciplinary action.

No “U” Turns in the vicinity of Start or Finish - **Observers are watching.** Head up and observe local regulations pertaining to the course at all times. Pace must not be given or received. The onus is on the overtaken rider to avoid this. Marshalls do not have the authority to control road users, so take care. Observers will be posted to ensure compliance with CTT Regulations.

Ensure that you review the Risk Assessment at time of signing on!

In the interests of safety Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets with an internationally accepted safety standard. **This is compulsory for all Juvenile and Junior riders.**

#### **All Competitors- please be aware of new CTT Regulation 14(1)**

No competitor shall be permitted to start a Type A or a Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the Rear of their machine a working rear red light either flashing or constant and that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users. **PLEASE NOTE NO REAR LIGHT- NO RIDE**
