Sports Pavilion, near west end of Church Lane, Ashington

Church Lane, Ashington, West Sussex. RH20 3JX.



Toilet open from 05:30; 2nd building from west end of Church Lane, opposite the church.

Parking: use recreation ground beyond barrier, drive in between hedge at side of bungalow and the first white building on right hand side of road beyond private houses/bungalows.

1st building is Youth Club, not available.

Toilet in next building going west.

2nd building is Sports Pavilion and access to toilet only.

3rd building is Scout hall, not available, but we can use car park between buildings.

HQ not open; toilet is, one in one out.

Numbers outside HQ only. After the event please return your number to the bowl/bucket of disinfected water. Please remember to sign back in after the event.

HQ to start: 5.5 miles (allow 30 minutes)

Route to start: This will be signed with 5 CTT arrows, marked, START.

Left, outside Sports Pavilion, then left (north), right at roundabout and left to join A24 north. North to traffic lights, where turn right onto A272.

Finish to HQ: 3.00 miles

Please note the following CTT regulations and recommendations

Helmets: CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

Competitors' Machines: It is required that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

Competitors' Vehicles: No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish (District regulation).

Safety Instructions:Details of any additional hazards not listed on the start sheet will be displayed at the signing on point. Competitors must exercise extra care when negotiating all roundabouts.

Warming Up: Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the event has started.

Observers: Official observers will be stationed around the course to ensure correct procedure (e.g. drafting and safety at roundabouts).

Results: No times will be given out at the finish line.

Race Numbers: The race number is made of fluorescent material which is an important safety feature. It is essential that it is placed correctly for maximum visibility to other road users and of course the timekeepers.

Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and Arm Numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forwards (not inwards).

Be aware that "No time may be recorded if the number is incorrectly positioned".



Additional Safety Instructions

Competitors must exercise extra care at the start and at all roundabouts.

Obey the two sets of pedestrian crossing lights in Cowfold.

REAR LIGHT COMPULSORY: NO ILLUMINATED REAR LIGHT=NO START

7)No push-off.

8)After racing, sign out, leaving your number in the bowl of disinfected water.

10)No result board – top 10 to be on CTT website's news later on Sunday.

11)All times to be on CTT site's results on Monday/Tuesday.
