POINTS

Points will be awarded on the basis of 60 points (in each category) for the winner down to 1 for sixtieth place in each event. The winners will be the riders with the highest aggregate total of points from up to four events. If more than one rider achieves the same number of points, then their 5th highest placing will be used to determine the winner. The Veteran categories are open to both Men and Women. Women Veterans will receive an additional 8 years on Target Time. The Veterans competitions will be run over the same distance as the Women's competition. The competition for Paracyclists is based on a "Factored Time" system.

Welcome from our President

Welcome to the 2021 Little Mountain Time Trial – a return to the traditional course starting in Great Witley and hopefully the restart of a full racing season. Naturally we have some changes in protocol due to COVID and these are detailed in the accompanying leaflet. However, although we cannot extend the same level of hospitality as we have done in the past, and will return to next year, underneath it all we have a great event and should see some really competitive racing. The event is now an established part of the National CTT sporting course series, now known as the Merlin Cycles Classic TT Series. The club have engaged a small army of volunteers to help stage the race and make the day a little bit special for everyone involved. The series is growing every year in importance and attracts many of the top UK time trialists.

In addition we now run a hugely popular roadman category – for those wanting to test their speed without either the cost or change in style from riding a TT bike, this is a perfect event. With the rolling nature of the course and some tough climbs, the road riders will be quicker on certain parts and contest an increasingly popular category.

This year the event is sponsored generously by AeroCoach boosting the prize fund and bringing their riders to the race – watch out for a lesson in aerodynamics in action.

With the additional prize money for the CTT series event there is an impressive prize list. Once again there are equal men's and women's prizes for the top three places and equal top prizes for the roadman categories.

We hope that everyone who rode last year will return. I must also give thanks to the local clubs, riders, friends and members of Beacon for their support and help in making this a special day.

Finding the HQ – Great Witley Village Hall, WR6 6HR

North of Worcester follow the A443 west from Holt Heath. Pass through Little Witley and on to Great Witley. As you come into the village the village hall is on your right, opposite the first left turn (B4197.

Important Notes for Competitors

<u>Signing On and Out</u> - Please sign on and collect your number from the HQ, which is situated in the Car Park at Great Witley Village Hall. At the end of the race please sign back in under new CTT regulations. The start is a very short distance from the HQ. Turn right outside the HQ then, immediately left on to the B4197 and the start is 40 yds ahead. Car parking at HQ will be limited due to the need for increased spacing. However additional parking will be available at Abberley Village Hall, Clows Top Rd, Abberley, Abberley Common, Worcester WR6 6AZ, approximately 1.7 miles from the HQ (see map below).

<u>CTT Clothing Rules</u> – Please note that under CTT rules you are not allowed to wear clothing with prominent commercial advertising unless your club has paid to be sponsored.

<u>Marshals</u> - Marshals will be posted at all junctions where a turn is required. However, riders are reminded that the onus is on you to know the course and to know where you are going!

<u>As you finish</u> – Please use the last breath in your lungs to shout out your number as you pass the chequered board. This really helps the finish officials if your number is obscured.

<u>Broom Wagon</u> - There will be no 'broom wagon' this year.

<u>Results and Prizes</u> – Results will not be available at the finish to avoid any temptation to stay after the event but hopefully we can look forward to a more convivial atmosphere in 2022. Instead times will be posted on the CTT site as soon as possible after the event. Prizewinners will be separately notified and cheques sent to all prizewinners to the address shown on their entry details.

<u>Warming up</u> - Please do not warm up past the start area after the race has started. For warm up please see map below.

Special Instructions

As the organiser of this year's Beacon RCC Little Mountain TT, which is being held during exceptional circumstances, my objectives are to stage a safe and Covid secure event and not attract any undue attention from local residents, or the wider public, regarding any perceived breeches of Covid regulations. I understand that this may impact on your overall enjoyment of the day, but the viability of future events depends upon our collective behaviour at this year's Little Mountain TT. With that in mind, please read and take careful note of the following race instructions.

Before the Event

• Please do not travel if you feel unwell, have any of the known Covid symptoms, have family members who have symptoms, or have tested positive in the last 10 days.

The HQ

- The HQ, Great Witley Village Hall, will only be available for toilet facilities and car parking.
- Sign on will be in the car park area.
- There are no changing facilities, so please change in your car.
- No catering will be provided.
- No results or result boards will be available at the HQ, results will be online after the event.
- Car parking will be restricted to double spaced parking, please follow instructions from our marshals.
- Additional parking, if required, will be available at Abberley Village Hall, WR6 6AZ, approximately 1.7 miles from the HQ. A parking marshal will also be available at that location. Please do not park in any of the nearby residential side roads within the village. Please consider all other road users when parking.
- Bring your own pen for signing on.
- Do not congregate in groups of more than two and always keep 2m apart.
- Please remain in your car other than signing in/out, warming up or racing.
- Toilet facilities will be operating on a one in, one out basis. Please use hand washing facilities provided.
- No Turbos or rollers to be used for pre-race warm up.
- Please warm up on the road circuit as indicated in this booklet.

The Race

- Please present to the time keeper no more than 5 minutes before your start time.
- Do not leave personal items, such as clothing, with the time keeper.
- There is no pusher-off. Riders must have one foot on the tarmac at start.
- During the race please observe CTT guidance on passing riders and being passed.
- There will be no event road side assistance or broom wagon. Riders must carry spare tubes, tools and a means of inflating tyres.

Post Race

- No results are available at the event.
- On finishing, competitors MUST NOT stop at the finish and MUST NOT loiter at the HQ/ car park and MUST pack away and leave immediately upon completion of the race.
- Please sign out.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

ROAD BIKE CRITERIA

- No tri bars, clip on bars or Spinaci bars
- No disc wheels. Both front and rear wheels must have a minimum of 12 spokes each. The maximum rim depth on all wheels is 65mm
- No aero helmet or a helmet that covers the ears or a helmet with a visor is to be used
- · Riders must not ride with their forearms resting on the handlebars at any time

NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

REGULATION 14(i)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF. N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY,

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15, all competitors under the age of 18 and/or juniors <u>MUST</u> wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
