50 miles time trial

Promoted for and on behalf of the Cycling Time Trials under their rules and regulations by the Burton & District Cycling Alliance on the 10th of July 2021. The event HQ is at Hilton village hall, Peacroft Lane, DE65 5GH. Plenty of parking at HQ. Do not forget to sign off after your ride.

To the start. From hall gates, straight ahead to T junction. Left to next T junction. Right here to the start just along this road. Two minutes.

No U turns in the starting area. Cycling Time Trials advise the wearing of a hardshell helmet that meets internationally safety standards. A working rear light to be fitted to the rear of the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Covid 19 regulations.

If you are feeling unwell or are showing signs of Covid 19, DO NOT attend this event.

Do not arrive too early or you will be asked to remain in your vehicle.

Please wear a face covering at appropriate times.

There will be toilets but these are not to be used as changing facilities. Due to Covid regs riders are to change in their vehicles.

The use of turbo trainers is only permitted if social distancing is maintained, preferable, warm upon the road.

There will be no gatherings in the car park. When signing on and out, maintain social distances.

Hand sanitisers will be available.

When you have finished the race you will be expected to return your number, sign out and leave.

Riders not adhering to the restrictions in place will not be permitted to ride and will be reported to the CTT and may be refused entry to future events.

These restrictions are not here to make it difficult for you or the volunteers. They are to minimise the risk of spreading the virus.

The course A50/6R Note that this is a two circuit course. The onus is on the rider to be familiar with the course.

Start on the A5123 at Hilton at the eastern end of the bus layby.

At roundabout take the first exit. At next roundabout left and up the sliproad to join the A50 westbound.

Proceed through three roundabouts (Sudbury, Uttoxeter Derby Road and Uttoxeter McDonalds) to take the sliproad at the JCB interchange. A522.

At the top of the sliproad right at the roundabout and cross over the A50 to turn right at the next roundabout and rejoin the A50 eastbound. Care as the road turns back upon itself.

Proceed through three roundabouts to take the sliproad at Derby West. A516. On this sliproad do not move into the right hand lane too soon as this causes congestion.

At Willowpit roundabout turn right, under A50, to next roundabout where right and rejoin A50 westbound.

End of first circuit

Repeat the first circuit and at Willowpit roundabout the second time take the second exit onto the A516 to finish approximately 10 yards before Ashe Lane. 50.03 miles.

Local regulation forbids U turns on the A516 after finishing. Failure to abide by this regulation will lead to disqualification. Continue to Seven Wells roundabout and turn here.
