MESSAGE FROM THE EVENT SECRETARY GARY JACKSON

Compared to last year, this year's event has been a breeze to organize. No last minute Police issues, no having to arrange a hundred different processes to remain Covid safe, and no terrible weather to deal with. On the contrary, we had 27 degrees by midday, so a big well done goes to all finishers. We did have a new course because of road works on the A14 (that are due to end just after our event!). The F2 is very comparable to the E2, flat, straight, with just a few roundabouts to deal with on a fifty. Next year with a bit of luck we will be back on the E2.

Entries were down on last year, when we were hugely over subscribed. This was probably because last year we were the first open event to go ahead after the initial lock down and riders were chomping at the bit to get out there in competition. But this year has been a relatively normal year for events, and some may have been skeptical about the change of course. We had 88 entries, but 14 riders sent apologies because of Covid 'pings' and isolation, and various other issues. 10 more did not turn up on the day, possibly because they saw the temperature and felt it was not going to be a fast day.

Now for the Thanks.

Becki and Tim Groves were available after timing the Shaftesbury Middle Markers in April on the same course. They must be very busy this year as several time keepers have had to call it a day with isolation issues. The HQ at Caldecote Village Hall was perfect with plenty of parking and an ideal size hall to have the signing on table. It's also only a mile and a half from the start, a lot handier than Westley Waterless. It's a pity it's not near the E2.

Getting marshals was slightly easier this year as the F2 needs less marshals than the E2, mainly because there are only two roundabouts that riders go round, and round, and round,,,, At the start, making sure rear lights were working and riders remained out of the way of traffic was our stalwart marshal Derek Brandon, veteran of many a TT and always the first to volunteer. At the first roundabout, directing riders on to the dual carriageway for the first of many laps was Jim Green, last year's Sargeant Major at the start.

At the Caxton Gibbet roundabout, resisting the temptation of McDonalds were Andrew Wenham (who should be riding next year), Laurence Bellamy, Geoff Fletcher and checking rider numbers, Nick McAuliffe.

At the slip road at Madingley was Paul Looke, making sure riders didn't carry on to Cambridge (some tried), and on the roundabout were Paul Chase, Andrew Glessing, Rob Moore and Richard Stevens. Checking numbers was Ian Jackson, yes, a relation. At the finish helping the time keeper to check numbers and texting results to HQ was Jim Poulain, showing vets can use a phone too.

Putting out all the signs to ensure riders knew exactly where to find us and where to turn was Paul Hirst. Many riders were very complimentary of the excellent signage.

Once again the biggest thank you of all must go to Keith West, who did all the handicapping, emailing riders with start sheets, handled all the finish times and double checking with the times recorded around the course by the number checkers to eliminate any possible errors, and to finally putting out the official times.

Congratulations go to Christopher McNamara for the fastest time of 1hr 38m 36s, a new course record, Alice Lethbridge fastest lady in 1hr 46m 52s, Samuel Howes 1st on Handicap, Colin Lizieri 1st Vet on Standard, and to the Shaftesbury team.
