Pusher off: Steve Wilkinson will be available, It's the rider's choice whether to make use of the "pusher off". Following CTT Covid regulations Steve will have had a flow test prior to the event and will wear a mask for the whole of the event.

Please note the following Covid 19 Regulations issued by the CTT.

Competitors should not attend if they feel ill in ANY way or if family members have any symptoms.

An elevated resting heart rate or exceptionally quick to react heart rate during warm up can suggest an underlying asymptomatic illness of ANY kind. You should NOT start the event (DNS) and leave immediately. Do not go to the start line if you feel this is the case and notify the organiser of your intention not to start as a result of an adverse warm up.

Warming up is permitted on static rollers can be permitted if strict social distancing can be maintained.

Course Details: <u>START</u> 0.36 miles east of Braithwaite Institute at the eastern side of the westerly junction of the old road where it joins the A66.

Proceed east to the A591 Keswick/Bothel roundabout. Encircle roundabout and retrace along A66, past the start. Continue to roundabout junction with the A5086 Cockermouth/Egremont road.

Encircle roundabout and retrace to finish at mark in road opposite BT inspection cover in verge on south side of road and 0.37 miles west of Braithwaite Institute

The following local regulations will apply:

Local Reg No 5

For the duration of the event, competitors must not ride past the timekeepers, except when actually competing.

Local Reg No 6

Any competitor making a 'U' turn in the vicinity of the start or finish will be disqualified from the event.

Local Reg No 9

No parking on the A66 except in a designated lay-by. No competitor parking in the Start/Finish lay-by on any A66 course.

Local Reg No 15

Riders must keep to the left-hand side of the road except when overtaking. Failure to comply with the above may lead to disqualification.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE:

Riders must give their number at the finish and elsewhere on the course if requested.

Riders must NOT STAND in the road at the start or finish. (This constitutes obstruction and is a breach of Regulations).

Riders must NOT ride with their heads down.

Helmets:

All competitors under the age of 18 and/or JUNIORS must wear a HELMET of HARD/SOFT SHELL construction that conforms to a recognised Standard (See Regulation 15).

The CTT state that helmets are Mandatory for all riders under the age of 18.

Cycling Time Trials strongly **recommends ALL** competitors to wear such a helmet.

HEADQUARTERS. In light of the recent increases in the Covid Infections the North DC committee would ask that the HQ, Braithwaite Institute, only be used for the toilet facilities.

There will be a one-way system where Signing on/off and race numbers will be available.

There will be light refreshments available if restrictions allow.

Riders MUST sign the signing on sheet in the HQ in order to obtain their race number and sign out when returning their number.

A copy of the risk assessment will be available for viewing.

If, however, the infection rate does not continue to rise then the HQ will be open to all, WITH CARE.

There will also be a presentation if Covid restrictions allow, this will take place, outside the HQ weather permitting, following each event.

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Best-selling author William Fotheringham has teamed up with Cycling Time Trials to offer selected women's time trial championship finishers in 2021 the chance to win copies of William's biography of Britain's greatest ever woman time triallist, Beryl Burton. Published in late 2019, *The Greatest: the Times and Life of Beryl* Burton was written with the help of Beryl's daughter Denise, and other members of the time trialling fraternity including the late Mike McNamara.

Five signed copies of The Greatest will be given away after each of the following CTT women's championships: the '100' on July 4, the '25' on August 8, the '50' on August 29, and the '10' on September 11. The books will be given to the five riders who finish closest – either slower or faster - to the time Burton set in winning the respective championship for the final time. In addition, five more will be given at the end of the season to the five riders finishing closest – again slower or faster – to the speed Burton set in winning her last BAR in 1983.

"I've been wanting to offer some copies of the book to Beryl Burton's successors today for some time," said Fotheringham, "but last year it seemed a bit complicated to do anything because we were in the middle of the Covid-19 pandemic. The idea is that rather than give copies to the fastest finishers in each event, we can spread the prizes around, and also offer up a direct comparison with the times that Burton was setting, without aerodynamic aids of course. For example, Burton's 1983 BAR speed would have earned her 10th place in 2019. It just seems like a fun way of commemorating Britain's greatest time triallist."

Burton last won the '25' and '50' in 1986, with times of 1-1-43 and 2-03-47 respectively. Her last victories in the '10' and '100' came in 1981, with times of 23-17 and 4-13-17. Her average for her 25th and last BAR in 1983 was 25.219mph.

In addition, CTT members will be able to claim a 15% discount on copies of The Greatest bought through Fotheringham's website <u>www.williamfotheringham.com</u> between July 4 and October 31, when the national hill-climb championship will close the 2021 season.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

REGULATION 14(i)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF. N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY,

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15, all competitors under the age of 18 and/or juniors must wear protective hard shell helmets.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
