Take 1st exit left onto A40 towards Raglan rbt. Encircle Raglan rbt M (8.7miles) taking 5th exit left onto A40 westbound back towards Abergavenny. After A40 bends from west to north-west, Finish at Joint #271 in entrance splay of next lay-by, 15.011 miles. Start SO 31430 11448; Finish SO 31468 11128</p>
