## 2020 & 2021 ESCA Competitions and Award Winners

The 2020 season was curtailed after the ESCA Hard Riders of 15 March 2020 due to the pandemic. Two more events were held in 2020, the September 10 and the October hill climb with the September 25 being cancelled due to roads works on both the usual course and the reserve course.

The Hard Riders and Two up TT early in 2021 were cancelled due to lockdown but the remaining seven events were all run successfully. At the time of preparing this document the awards for 2021 had not been published prior to the display and presentation of trophies in Fairwarp Village after the ESCA 25 on 24 April 2022.

## 2022 ESCA Best All Rounder Competitions & Rules

### **Senior Best All Rounder:**

Contested over 25, 50 and 100 miles in any ESCA event this season. Based on an average mph from the best performance at each distance. Senior Team Based on the average mph of the best three Senior BAR qualifiers from an ESCA affiliated club.

### **Lady Senior Best All Rounder:**

Contested over 10, 25 and 50 miles in any ESCA event this season. Based on an average mph from the best performance at each distance

### **Junior Best All Rounder:**

Contested over 10 and 25 miles in any ESCA event this season. Based on an average mph from the best performance at each distance.

### **Long Distance ESCA Best All Rounder Table:**

Contested over 25, 50 and 100 miles in any ESCA event this season.

### **Short Distance ESCA Best All Rounder Table [new for 2022]:**

Contested over 10, 25 and 50 miles in any ESCA event this season.

## 2022 ESCA Points Competition & Rules

### **Individual Points:**

Points are awarded to any individual first claim rider from an ESCA affiliated club in each qualifying event:  
30 points for first place down to 1 point for 30th place

### **Ladies Individual Points:**

Points are awarded to any individual first claim female rider from an ESCA affiliated club in each qualifying event:

10 points for first place down to 1 point for 10th place

### **Club Points:**

Points are awarded to any club affiliated to ESCA based on the performance of its individual first claim members in each qualifying event. The individual points earned by each first claim rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club:

30 points for first place down to 1 point for 30th place

## **2022 ESCA Trophies**

With the exception of the Brian Phillips Trophy, donated by East Grinstead CC in memory of their teammate Brian Phillips, which applies to the September 25, all other 10 and 25 mile trophies are awarded for the best performance at either the March, April or September events.
