### Parking and Use of the HQ

Some parking is available at the HQ and to maximise use of this please park reasonably closely together and do not take up parking space for static warm-ups. For those unable to park at the HQ please take note of the following:

- If parking on Marsh Lane or adjacent roads please do so with consideration for local residents and avoid blocking drives etc.
- In particular do not park on both sides of the road near the HQ. **At a past event the parked vehicles of some riders prevented a regular service bus getting through and the implications for emergency vehicles are extremely serious.**
- There are laybys on the old A46 before and after the start but do not park at the start.
- There is a very wide verge suitable for parking on the old A46 south of Eden Hall roundabout and only about half a mile from the start.

**Please give consideration to local residents and all other road users in the area so that we can continue to use this venue as a Headquarters**

## **Numbers and Signing-on/off:**

Numbers will be at the HQ and can be collected when you sign-on. Please remember that you must sign-out after the event. This is to ensure that you are available for the Drug Test team if they attend the event. **Failure to sign out will result in a DNF classification.** You should sign-out when you return your number in exchange for a drink after your ride.

## **PLEASE REMEMBER:**

The use of working **front and rear lights**, whether flashing or constant, fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to other road users and active whilst the machine is in use **is mandatory**. **A hard shell helmet is also mandatory.**  
**Compliance will be checked at the start line.**  
**No lights and helmet – no ride.**

## **Safety:**

Do not stop at the finish timekeeper but proceed for a short distance, make a U turn when safe to do so and return to the HQ to return your number and sign out.  
The A46 is a major trunk road so please take no chances and ride safely. Your welfare is worth more than your PB.

## **Start and warm up:**

To get to the start proceed south along Marsh road then left onto Main Street then right onto Fosse Rd. You are now on the last mile of the course so be aware of riders finishing. Proceed quickly and in single file past the finish making it obvious that you are not racing. The start is just after East Stoke. Please do not arrive at the start more than 5 minutes before your start time and warm up south of Eden Hall traffic island.  
Between Farndon and Eden Hall please be aware of riders starting and finishing on this road. No competitors' cars at the start and riders should exercise social distancing whilst waiting to start.  
**There will be no pusher-off.**

## **A25/34 - 25 mile Course**

**Start:** at the speed derestriction sign on southbound exit from East Stoke on old A46. Proceed south to **Turn Left** at traffic island (near Eden Hall) to pass over A46 to **Turn Left** onto A46 southbound slip road. On A46, proceed south to take slip road from A46 to traffic roundabout at junction to Cropwell Bishop & Cotgrave (**Stragglethorpe Junction**). Take 4<sup>th</sup> exit to pass under the A46 to second roundabout. (Approx 10.4mls.) Take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit to slip road onto A46 northbound and proceed towards Newark. At **Farndon roundabout** take first exit onto old A46 (Fosse Way). (Approx 23.15mls.) Proceed south on old Fosse Way to finish 36 yards before the start of fence on RHS at gateway to River Trent and just before Stoke Warren Farm on approach to East Stoke. (25.00mls.).

## **COVID 19 REGULATIONS.**

Although most restrictions have now been lifted it is essential that everyone follows any remaining government requirements and takes sensible precautions to respect the potential concerns of everyone else. This is particularly relevant at the HQ since the people managing the results and the provision of refreshments will be in the building for several hours.

- If you feel at all unwell or are showing signs of Covid 19 **DO NOT** come to this event.
- An elevated resting heart rate or exceptionally quick to react heart rate during warm up can suggest an underlying asymptomatic illness of any kind and the rider should DNS and leave immediately and not go to the start line if you feel this is the case.
- If you have any doubts you should obtain a lateral flow test prior to attending the event.
- Under no circumstances attend an event following a positive test.
