Course T102

Start at grating on east side of old A19, 40 yards North post at gateway, approx.350 yards South of Crathorne village. Proceed South to join A19. Continue to Cleveland Tontine (4.98 miles) Turn sharp left and left again (care) onto A172 Stokesly Road. Continue over bridge to join A19 Northbound (5.704 miles) Proceed North on A19 to finish at 3rd grating from north end of layby approx 0.75 miles South of Crathorne/Picton Road Bridge over A19 (10 miles)

Riders will continue along A19 coming off at junction at A67 and retrace to HQ at Crathorne

Numbers will be at event HQ at Crathorne Reading Rooms where RIDERS must sign on AND OFF, riders not signing-off will be recorded as DNF.

Parking is available, turn right at the turning just past the village pub and post office on the road adjacent to the Cricket Pitch.
