You and your club mates can compete for these in events that are held throughout the racing season.

All SCCU events count for trophies, and where applicable the South Eastern RC Open 10.

#### Season long awards:

Mens' individual BAR (Claud Butler Trophy) based on the best average speed at 25, 50 and 100 miles.

Team BAR (Amateur Cup) best of three (men or women) from any one club.

Veterans' BAR (John Smith Cup) (men and women) based on VTTA standards.

Womens' BAR (Fleming Cup) based on the best average speed at 10, 25 and 50 miles.

Junior BAR Coronation Cup) based on the best average speed at 10 and 25 miles.

Rawson Shield awarded annually to club with the hightest number of entrants in SCCU road promotions.

#### Specific awards:

Fountain Cup - fastest SCCU member in a Union promoted 25 miles TT.

Robin Marsh Trophy - fastest SCCU junior in a SCCU 25.

Vice-Presidents' Tankard - fastest SCCU member in the Union's Open 50 miles TT.


Roberts Shield - best team of three SCCU members in the Union's Open 50 miles TT.
