

OFFICIAL RESULT

This is the official result for the 2024 WCA 12-hour TT event, promoted for and on behalf of Cycling Time Trials under their rules and regulations.

We are delighted to confirm that the event produced two new WCA records and, from what we've heard, several PBs and club records too. **Julie HOOPER** (Cwmcarn Paragon CC) clocked up 211.00 miles in her first ever 12-hour ride to win the C5 category and set a benchmark that future paracyclists will strive to beat. And in a thrilling climax to the event, **Alexander ROYLE** (Manchester Bicycle Club) set a new standard for the open category with a distance of 305.96 miles to improve the WCA record by 0.12 miles. This equates to a road distance of **211 yards**, meaning that Alexander's average speed was **18 yards per hour** quicker than Anthony JONES' 2021 record. Putting it another way, when Alexander matched Anthony's 12-hour distance his own clock stood at **11:59:43**. Remarkable!

The women's title goes to **Michelle LINDLEY** (Poole Wheelers CC) with a superb performance of 259.25 miles – another ride that at times threatened the WCA record.

Congratulations go to these and all riders who took part on the day. Whatever the outcome, we hope you enjoyed your time with us and will be back in 2025 to give it another go.

FINISHING PROTOCOL

Speaking of 2025, a small tip for riders unfamiliar with the protocol when the twelve-hour period expires. In time-based events (12h and 24h) if you are between timekeepers at the moment your individual clock expires (which, realistically, will usually be the case), then you should continue riding until you reach the next TK station. You will then be credited for part of the distance between those two TK stations, based on your speed over that final section of the course. We have a few instances of riders reaching a TK just before their clock expired but then not reaching the next TK. Unfortunately, for those riders we cannot award any further mileage beyond the TK where they were last seen. It's not a big factor but, as you've seen from the result, sometimes the smallest of margins can make all the difference when it comes to course records, PBs, club records, etc.

RESULTS AND AWARDS

As mentioned in the race booklet, we have many award categories. Caps and medallions will be distributed by post and the WCA will shortly be discussing additional possibilities regarding prize giving; if there's more to be said on that front, we'll be in touch.

SUMMARY OF RESULTS

The following table provides a summary of the results based on:

- > the morning legs to Monmouth, Usk, Hereford and Abergavenny amounting to a distance of 90.980 miles;
- > midday circuits of 25.790 miles, starting and ending at the Hardwick roundabout;
- > a transitional leg of 7.921 miles to commence the finishing circuit;
- finishing circuits of 15.484 miles;
- > a partial finishing lap, to a TK station just before the expiry of the 12h clock;
- part of the distance to the next TK station, just after the expiry of the 12h clock.



Distances are calculated to several decimal places without rounding but, in accordance with CTT regulations, riders' final results are then rounded **down** (truncated) to two decimal places. On the CTT event page you will find a more detailed version of this table.
