Report: A breezy but warm and sunny day was found by the riders – certainly decent conditions if not perfect, and we steered clear of the heavy rain. There’s very little relationship between finish position and bib number, so conditions likely remained similar throughout.

There was one unfortunate none finisher due to an accident on course.

Particular thanks are due to the time keepers, Maggie Smith (finish) and Christina Demetriou (start – and making her timekeeping debut!) kept things running smoothly and we were ably helped by a good number of volunteer helpers listed above, many thanks to them all – and turned out well to have a few more than were absolutely required. The competitors and event team fuelled and warmed with teas and coffees, special thanks to Steph Bird for manning the kitchen (and my daughter for some keen washing up when mugs were running short!).

The tandem event had 2 entries, won by Ray and Wendy Bennett in a time of 23:59 beating David and Hannah Newman 27:10.

The solo event had 7 finishers inside 22 minutes. The winner was Chris Bartley (AS Test Team) in 19:03, believed to be a course record by some margin, he was nearly 1 minute ahead of second placed Ryan Davies (AS Test Team) in 20:01 and third placed James Cadman (Hounslow & District Whs) in 21:14.

In the women’s event the winner was Anastasia Bowler (AS Test Team) with 22:39, Jen Magill (Reading CC) came in second in 23:40 who edged out third placed Jo Buckland (PDQ Cycle Coaching) 23:42.

It was close in the veterans, 9 riders with +5 minutes, the winner was Nicolas Philip Watts (North Hampshire RC) with +5:49, 2nd place Simon Bowler (AS Test Team) with +4:45, who just edged out Jo Buckland (PDQ Cycle Coaching) with +5:34.

Best trike prize goes to Lez Young (Lincoln Wheelers CC) in 26:45 (+5:05 VTTA).

The team prize goes comfortably to AS Test Team (Chris Bartley, Ryan Davies & Simon Bowler), with a total of 1:02 (so nearly under the hour for all 3 combined). In fact they had 4 riders, and the times of any 3 of the 4 were good enough to comfortably win this prize.

Prizes will be sent out by post shortly.

Thank you to all the riders, I hope you enjoyed the event despite the incident. My special thanks go to timekeepers, helpers and marshals that contributed their effort to making the event run smoothly. I hope to see you all again next year.
