## **Credit where credit is due:**

Congratulations to all of you that rode. It is usual practise to just mention the prize winners and the new record holders (which I will do in a minute), but something that is so wonderful about time trailing is its inclusivity, and the creation of a separate event for road bikes is opening up the sport to so many new people and it was great to see so many of you entering the road bike event and just having a go.

As well as having international superstars riding, we also had some people riding their first ever time trial, so I must mention Rebekah Smith and Lewis Rose who both did magnificent rides on, what is, a very challenging course. I am not sure whether they knew what they had let themselves in for – but I hope the experience hasn't put them off!

A mention must also go to Dave Jarvis. Anyone under 50 will have no idea who he is but, trust me, the man is a superstar of the sport and it is great to see him back racing.

In contrast to the Rutland event a few weeks ago, you were all treated to perfect weather conditions, and therefore it was not a surprise to see records being updated. What was a surprise was how much the records were improved by! First mention goes to the new 'Queen of the Course' Hayley Simmonds. Hayley not only demolished the road bike record; she also went faster than any female by taking almost a minute from Lizzy Bank's absolute record. A record, which, I had expected to stay on the shelf a long time. Many congratulations Hayley.

Jude Taylor roared around the course on his road bike in a time that would usually win the event outright and in doing so he took the best part of 2 minutes from Andy Nichol's record. Andy himself also beat his previous best, but he had to settle for 2<sup>nd</sup> on this occasion.

FINALLY(!) after 10 editions of the event. a juvenile rider graced the start sheet. This was great in itself, but Ryan Williams also proved what an outstanding prospect he is by establishing an incredible record of 47.43. (A note to messrs Taylor, Nichols et al.: keep an eye on this young man because he will very soon be challenging you!).

On the subject of 'firsts' we also had the first all-female team competing, so huge congratulations to Melissa, Catherine and Smudge from the mighty 'Ilson Cycling Club' for establishing an excellent record for others to now aim at. Hopefully, the example you have set will encourage many other all-female teams to enter.

Local legend Kevin White added another achievement to his already very long list by removing 2 minutes from his previous record for the fastest vet on a road bike. It is also worth noting that he was the fastest vet over the 2 events.

Commiserations #1: to Richard Golding who wasn't able to finish due to a mechanical. Richard was number 13 and when he signed on, I definitely said something along the lines of "you'll be fine, in fact I reckon this will bring you luck". Er..... Richard – if you come back next year, I'll refund your entry fee!

Commiserations #2: to Kieron Salt for going off course, but regardless he soldiered on to record a time in circumstances in which many people would have given up. Well done!
