Some things take a while to sink in. But the 2021 National Hill Climb Champs on Winnats Pass already feel pretty special. Riders, marshals, spectators, photographers, non-cycling fans who happened to be in the area, local people who decided to come out and see what was going on – all of them have commented on how great the event was and how it'll live long in the memory.

With its horrendous gradients and steep valley sides, Winnats provided the perfect scene, but there were many other factors that made the event what it was. Torrential rain added an extreme element, and it was really captivating to watch riders battling their way up the hill, fighting wheel slip, pain etched on faces and eyes searching desperately for the top! The crowd added a surreal aspect. As a rider it felt almost other-worldly. The crowd weren't just cheering people on, they were ferociously willing them on. It seemed like it wasn't just the rider against the hill, it was the rider backed up by the crowd trying to absolutely obliterate the hill! It was a crazy experience.

None of it would have been possible without the marshals, the car park attendants, the HQ helpers, the photographers, the commentator, the time-keepers (hand and electronic), the clerks, the holder-uppers, the start co-ordinators, the finish team, the catchers, the kit-bag transporters, the guys on the road closures. All those people put in long, hard shifts with a smile on their faces and made the event what it was. We had over 60 helpers on the day, from Rutland CC and several other local cycling clubs – this was an event that was too big for one club to organise on its own and it was brilliant to see the local cycling community come together and muck in. Very many thanks to all those who volunteered. Particularly big thanks to Adam Lathbury, Gordon Wordsworth, Toby Wilson, and Marc Etches, who each took on huge amounts of work. Their dedication and willingness to help was as monumental as the event!

A special mention also to my co-organiser, Chris Myhill, whose reassuring presence over the last 2 years has always provided a reminder of what we were trying to do, and why. We'd look at photos of Championship races on Winnats from over 40 years ago and imagine trying to recreate them. I think we did, and more. In fact, there are thousands of amazing photos from many talented photographers chronicling the event, which will help the memories made last long into the future.

Thanks also to our sponsors, whose amazing support has allowed us to raise enough money to donate over £3,000 to local causes, which will make a real difference to the local community and really got the local people on our side. Who knows, maybe they'll let us do it again one day.

Finally, congratulations to all the riders. There were many phenomenal rides. If this is to be the last hill climb on Winnats for a long time, this year's champions are fully deserving of long reigns.

The first national hill climb championship I participated in was in 1988, and since then I have ridden in many nationals and have promoted many events. I have seen incredible spectacles and have experienced many special days, but there is no doubt in my mind that the 2021 national hill climb on Winnats is the craziest, most memorable, and most extraordinary event I have been involved with. It is also, without any shadow of a doubt, the most emotional.

It has been an enormous privilege to have been involved in the event's promotion and, an even bigger privilege, to work alongside a group of people who shared the vision for putting the national back on Winnats and having the bravery to take on such a huge task. My co-organiser, Nick Latimer, assembled an extraordinary team of talented, passionate individuals who, at the onset, were slightly nervous about what we had taken on. But through teamwork, commitment and sheer determination, we all gained strength from each other and I will never forget the moment when we were granted the road closure and Winnats 'was on'!

In the final few weeks before the race we experienced some big challenges when one of our headline suppliers had to pull out of the event. But by this time, such was the momentum of the team, the challenge was met head on, and we had a solution within a couple of days.

In the days running up to the event it became clear that the event was going to be run off in challenging weather conditions, so we put plans into place to deal with this and then hoped that the crowds would still come.

We were not disappointed.

People literally turned up in their thousands and created an atmosphere that has only been rivalled in the UK by the Tour de France's visit to Yorkshire in 2014. We always knew that Winnats would be very, very special. The unrelenting nature of the gradient makes it one of the toughest tests in the UK, but it is the gorge that it goes through which makes it special. The steep sides of the valley create a natural amphitheatre for the spectators, compressing the noise and chaos into a narrow funnel, and the sight of the climbers parting the crazed, sodden crowds as they inched their way up the fierce gradient, against a curtain of rain, is a vision that is etched onto my memory.

The organisers job is to create the framework for an event to take place. We simply provide the stage for the participants to perform upon and it is those participants, in the form of the riders and the spectators, who bring the event alive. On Winnats, last Sunday, those participants surpassed all our expectations, and combined with the hill and the weather conditions, a perfect moment was created in British hill climbing history.

Winnats has a history and prestige unrivalled by any climb in the UK. It is peerless. On 10 previous occasions the King of Winnats was crowned and, in becoming so, they each became a giant of the sport. This history, as rich as it was, had one thing missing - there had never been a queen. This all changed on Sunday 31st October 2021 when the first Queen of Winnats was crowned. And her name is Bithja Jones.

It was the crowning moment of a glorious day that will be remembered for long time by many, many people.


