RESULTS ON STANDARD: (VTTA Members only)

Explanation: Each year, a table of age standards is published in the VTTA Year Handbook. Each age has a target (standard) time, according to distance, gender, type of machine (solo, trike, tandem). Starting at a 40year old, a man's standard is 26:06mins for a 10. The corresponding women's standard is 28:33mins. There is an increment increase in standard for each age. The standard awards go to the rider who has the largest plus (the largest amount of time that a rider beats their standard time by).

RESULT ON HANDICAP TIME:

Explanation: For those new to time trialling, the handicap system is calculated as follows: The rider with the fastest recorded time is allocated the "Scratch" time. I.E. 0:00. Each rider's handicap allowance is then calculated on their best recorded time in last three seasons against the scratch time.

E.G. The scratch rider has recorded a fastest time of 19:00mins for 10 miles. A rider whose best is 24:00 minutes would be allocated an allowance of 5:00mins. Following the event, the allowance is deducted from the rider's time. The winner being the rider with the fastest handicap time. It is felt that this rewards a rider that either rides consistently to their fastest recorded time or improves on their submitted recorded best time.
