Congratulations to the prize winners, most of whom stayed behind to pick up their prize money after the event. Many thanks to those that don't take their winnings, the monies retained by ESCA going towards an end of season donation to a charity, probably Kent, Surrey & Sussex Air Ambulance.

If anyone did not pick up their prize money they can drop the organiser a line to confirm they are content not to claim it, or provide their PayPal details. The deadline for claiming payment is Saturday 5th November.

Nick Martin sat alongside finish timekeeper and entered times in to ResultSheet to give a live leader board on smart phones. If you are not familiar with the website it is worth checking it out at: <https://resultsheet.co.uk/> Many thanks to Brett Davis, and his team, for producing and continuing to develop very useful tool.

As riders returned their numbers and signed out some used the QR code by the sign out sheet to go straight to the event in ResultSheet to check their times. One rider was heard to say: "how do they get the times up so quickly when they are using a manual stopwatch?" Another was heard to advise a teammate "screen shot that – you are top rider [for now]!" Times were entered as stored in the stopwatch memory to one hundredths of a second. The results on the CTT web site, and now on ResultSheet, give times rounded up to the nearest tenth of a second as per CTT Reg 42 on page 351 of the 2022 CTT handbook and on the CTT website:

42. Units of Timing & Distance

Any part of a second in timing shall be recorded for all purposes as the next whole second except in the case of hill-climbs where timing shall be to 1/10th of a second. In 12 hour and 24 hour events distances shall be expressed to the nearest 1/100th of a mile covered.

Notwithstanding the above, in events that use an approved means of electronic chip timing, timing shall be recorded to 1/100th of a second.

No changes were made to the results available on the morning of the event.

Results were emailed to Snowdon Sports first thing Sunday morning and they soon produced an excellent report that is well worth a read on the CTT web site and available at:

Times were uploaded to the CTT web site on the Wednesday morning after the event. The result was promptly approved and a basic pdf result sheet was then immediately available to download from the CTT web site. The basic result pdf was replaced with this comprehensive Open, Double Header and Association result sheet on Sunday 30th October. The times on ResultSheet were rounded up to the next tenth of a second after the result was approved on the CTT web site.
