ARRANGEMENTS

EVENT HEADQUARTERS – Higher Heath Village Hall. Tremlovs Avenue. Press.
Whitchurch. SY132HE. Numbers are available at the signing on desk. Please remember to sign on and receive any other instructions. **Remember, that you are now required to sign out within a reasonable time after completing the event.**

START The start is approximately 2 miles distant at the SW-most post of metal gate at pull in adjacent to white concrete building on A 53 between Tern Hill island and Tern Hill Hall Hotel (SJ635321). There will not be a 'pusher-off'. **Riders must neither congregate or make U turns on the main carriageway and keep inside white lines whilst waiting to start.**

SAFETY Riders are reminded to ride with their heads up. You will be provided with a high visibility race number which should be worn in accordance with Regulation 16 for your own safety. All riders should obey the rules of the road and not indulge in any dangerous manoeuvres **ANYWHERE ON THE COURSE.**

FINISH The finish is on the old A53 level with the start of the metal barrier at the beginning of the bridge over Bailey Brook (SJ628316). **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MUST RIDERS OR CARS STOP AT THE FINISH. RIDERS MUST NOT MAKE U TURNS AFTER THE FINISH OR THEY RISK DISQUALIFICATION.**

RESULTS Results will be entered on the board as and when they are received. These results are provisional and the official results will be emailed out to riders.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control. As soon as you have finished you must return to HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at HQ. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby.

All riders must wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets internationally accepted safety standards. It is now a requirement that a working front and rear light, either flashing or constant, are fitted to your machine and are active whilst the machine is in use. Riders will not be allowed to start without such lights.
