Summary

There were 40 entrants of which 11 were females (27.5%); 11 riders did not start and everyone else finished. It was a warm afternoon with a bit of wind but one person still managed a pb.

Two entrants were not vets; Chris Bartley who was fastest overall with 19:24 and Anastasia Bowler who was the fastest female with 22:44.

Danuta Tinn was fastest overall on standard with a plus of 5:58 and Ian Greenstreet was the fastest male on standard with a plus of 5:43.

Two teams entered 3 riders but both had fewer than three finishers so no team medals were won.
