Many thanks for your support of our Club Open Charity Event. Hope you all enjoyed it despite the seemingly tough day. However, read on for an interesting insight into today's results.

Well, what a day!

Sherwood managed to produce 2 all-time Open Event PB's in Elaine Simpson and Stephen Clark, respectively in 24:02 and 23:49 and shaving some 42 seconds off their times.

Overall, 20 PB's were set across the field from as little as 1 second to 3 minutes and 12 seconds for Gretchen Zoeller of Ilkeston CC.

11 of those PB's were set in the first 60 riders and 9 set within the later riders. From this, it is possible to conclude that although the conditions were slightly less favourable for the later riders, it was not overbearingly so.

Conditions were not as optimal as it was predicted to be less than 24 hours before with the wind stiffening from 2.5 mph to 10 - 11mph. This caused a lot of suffering to a good proportion of riders, even at the top end of the field, with some class riders well adrift of their PB by as much as 1:40 whereas the likes of Ian Guilor missed out on his PB by a mere 10 seconds which was set this year on the E2/10. Ashley Cox missed his PB by 11 seconds set on the F2A/10 in July 2021. Had the wind been just a little more merciful, a lot more PB's would have been smashed today.

However, despite that people in the latter stages of the time trial recorded PB's of 1 minute in a couple of cases. To top the day off, Elaine Simpson (Sherwood CC) broke the all-time club ladies 10 mile TT record set in August 1985 which was most likely set on a road bike on the O2/10.

I am so pleased that 22.2% of riders today set a new personal best whilst slightly disappointed that the weather was not as kind. It leaves me wondering just how many more would have walked away elated with their performance had it been as predicted.

I am sure a good proportion of you will be pawing over your stats to see where you could have improved.

I have tried to make this results sheets a little more interesting than normal.

I would also welcome your critical constructive comments on the food and drinks provided and where we could improve on that. I know we were light on vegan food so some thoughts and simple ideas via email to me would provide some ideas for me going forward. The same goes for vegetarian and the carnivorous ones...
