# Firle Beacon Hill Climb Result Sheet

Many thanks to the efforts of members of ESCA affiliated clubs for putting the event on, and of course many thanks to the riders that entered.

Mathew Ferguson of Redhill CC has been on great form this hill climb season and won the event with a time of 4:03.4 on a damp morning. Second overall was 17 year old Cesare Masset (4:13.5) of Brighton Mitre with Daniel Pink of Bigfoot CC (4:20.0) third overall to take second place in the Open over 18 category.

Wendy Mathie of Penge Cycle Club won the Female category with a sub six minute over one minute clear of second placed 15 year old Rianna Mahoney of 4T+ Cyclopark. Wendy's time was announced as a sub five minute time in the prize presentation before being corrected in the afternoon. 14 year old Elanor Thompson of 4T+ Cyclopark was fourth so fifth placed Megan Godber of Brighton Mitre was the third placed woman.

Fastest Open Junior was Cesare Masset of Brighton Mitre, taking a very impressive second place overall as well. Second was Noah Stepney of Worthing Excelsior CC

Fastest Female Youth was Rianna Mahoney of 4T+ Cyclopark a fraction ahead of team mate Eleanor Thompson.

There were four Open Youths bringing the total of junior and youth finishers to eight, great to have youngsters riding.

It was good to have nine teams of three riders complete the climb for their clubs. Brighton Mitre A headed by junior Cesare were the fastest team of three ahead of Sussex Revolutions CC. See the times for the nine teams on a following page and note that the sixth placed team were the under 18's from 4T+ Cyclopark.

There were 21 riders from affiliated ESCA clubs in the 54 finishers. Adam Rogers of Eastbourne Rovers picked up enough points ahead of Peter Baker of Lewes Wanders to win the individual points competition. The individual points table can be found in ResultSheet.

Adam picked up enough points as the only Rover in the event to retain Rovers top spot in the club points table. Hastings closed in but fell just six points short of coming top of the table, which would have been the case had the club's two DNS had a ride and finished. Lewes retained third place, by one point. trainSharp and Brighton Mitre leapfrogged East Grinsted to go equal fourth, a massive jump for Mitre due to having seven finishers in the hill climb.

The club points table after six events in the series and the final table after seven events can be found in the Attached Files on the CTT web page for this event, the last in the series of seven counting events.

Congratulations to all of the prize winners, most of whom stayed behind to pick up their prize money after the event. Many thanks to those that don't take their winnings, the monies retained by ESCA going towards an end of season donation to charity: the Kent, Surrey & Sussex Air Ambulance.

If anyone did not pick up their prize money they can drop the organiser a line to confirm they are content not to claim it, or provide their PayPal details. The deadline for claiming payment is Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> November.
