7. 2024 VTTA Yorkshire Events

In 2024 we decided to arrange the 'Ice Breaker' our 'blue chip' event with a full programme of racing, pre event entertainment, a spectrum of awards, catering, hospitality and top standard HQ all done to our highest standard possible. This was our Blue Chip Event.

We will also organise a '10' and a '25' on fast courses to help those doing BAR competitions. We chose a full weekend to allow people to ride both events if travelling, utilising late afternoon and early morning slots. There are many reasonable accommodation places for those choosing an overnight stop. Not like the Ice Breaker, but good for fast BAR times, hopefully.

29th June, 2024 – V210 - '10' Start time 18:00 (due to district course restrictions) – important info, the VTTA hold this event over 10 miles exactly, it will not be long.

30th June, 2025 – V232 – '25' Start time 08:00: Note this is the old V232 course with just the one turn, so much quicker than the V232/1 or the V236/1 which have multiple complex turns where riders lose speed. This course has been very fast when it was in more regular use 10 years ago. It has not been used much as the HQ is quite a long way from the start. Please support this '25' so we can have at least one fast DC '25' in Yorkshire, rather than needing to make a pilgrimage to the well known E2 and F2.


The '25' will defenitely have results on Results sheet. We anticipate the '10' will also use results sheet, but this will be dependent on timekeeper available on the day.
