**BOTH EVENTS:**

CTT regulations require the use of a helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards for all competitors.

CTT regulations now require that no competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear light, and to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that are illuminated and positioned to be clearly visible to other road users.

London South DC strongly recommend that riders do not wear black or dark clothing during any event held on the public road.

Under 18 years old riders: Bring a completed parental consent form to present before signing-on.

No form = no ride.

London South DC Regulation: No vehicle, except those of the timekeepers and race officials, shall park in the vicinity of the start and finish areas.

*"Please remember that the riders you catch during the races will not be aware of your presence until you are actually passing them, so please give them sufficient space as you go by"*

No times will be given out at the finish.

Apart from riding to the start, no warming-up on the course once the event has started

Course GH/92:

Start in Bostal Road, Steyning, 42 yards west of junction with Clays Hill, road leading from Bramber roundabout, and at chipped kerbstone, 7 yards west of blue sign, “Single track road with passing places”. Proceed up Bostal Road. Past junction with Newham Lane to Finish at top of hill, opposite “South Downs Way” wooden “Footpath” sign and 34 yards past “Steep Hill” sign for descending traffic, (0.99 mile).

Start at 200 feet above sea level; 2 stretches of 17% before the Finish at 500 feet above sea level.

HQ to Start: 0.64 mile. Left away from HQ to small roundabout where first left then 3<sup>rd</sup> road on the right.

Course GH/99:

Start in Church Lane, Sompting, at pillar on north side of entrance to first house north of A27. Proceed northwards and continue, becoming Titch Hill which then becomes Bostal Road, Steyning to Finish at northern edge of concrete at a field entrance on west side of road where sets of double gates are on each side of the road opposite each other, (2.8 miles).

Start at 65 feet above sea level, 12% steepest to  
Finish 470 feet above sea level.

HQ to start: Go south on the morning hill-climb, Bostal Road, Steyning 4 miles to Sompting. There are lay-bys for parking in several places on the way but little parking between Sompting church and the start. It is suggested you allow half an hour to ride from the HQ to the start.
