London South District Regulation:

No vehicles, except those of the timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start and finish areas.

NUMBERS WILL BE AT THE HQ where you are required to SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT, in person (CTT reg). Please return numbers to the HQ after the event. Please note all competitors are now required personally to sign out when returning their number. Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

PLEASE replace pins in numbers should you remove them as an aid to a super quick ride. Thank you.

Competitors' Machines:

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.
