Event Notes

EVENT HQ:

Parish Hall, Church St, SHAWBURY SY4 4NH

- No overnight parking / camping.
- Limited car parking is available at the Hall and public car park across the road. If necessary, you may park on the **perimeter track** of the football pitch. Do **NOT** park on the pitch itself, or block access ways or park on the blind bend outside the Hall.
- The Hall and parking areas are near houses: please keep the noise down. Leave turbo trainers at home or find a quiet lay-by to warm up in.
- Bring your own pen, and pins for your number. Hand sanitiser will be available - please use it.
- Competitors **MUST NOT** leave any personal items with the time keeper or at Event HQ.
- No support will be provided if a competitor suffers mechanical difficulties. It is strongly advised that all competitors carry with them a spare inner-tube/tubular, pump and tyre levers if required.
- It is strongly advised that all competitors carry a mobile phone with the Event contact number. If you fail to finish the event, phone or text Event Secretary.

At Event HQ:

- **SIGN ON** and collect your number, and
- **SIGN OFF** and return your number.
- **Failure to sign off** will result in a DNF.

START: The start is approximately **3 miles from HQ** at a lay-by on the A53 between Shawbury and Espley. Please arrive at the start no more than 4 minutes before your start time. Do not obstruct the highway whilst waiting for your turn to start and keep well in to the left of the road or stand on the verge. Take care when pulling away.

COURSE:

- **District Local Regulations prohibit U-turns in the vicinity of the Start and Finish.** Any rider observed infringing this rule will be disqualified.
- **Prees and Tern Hill Roundabouts:** District Local Regulations require riders to negotiate these RABs in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the islands if traffic conditions require this. **Riders MUST NOT USE tri-bars / extensions** between the first bollard they pass on entering the island and the last bollard they pass leaving it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.
- **A41 Sandford Bridge:** You will pass over Sandford Bridge on your way to Prees Heath and on your way back to Tern Hill. The advisory speed limit is 30 mph. The road is narrow, twisty and badly surfaced - please exercise caution, do not 'undertake' traffic, and avoid bunching up.
- **Shawbury Garden Centre (A53):** After 10:00 there could be slow or stationary traffic at the entrance. You must obey the Highway Code when attempting to overtake any such traffic.
- **Pedestrian Crossing Lights (A442, Crudgington):** Riders are required to observe the lights and to stop if required. Any rider seen to be in breach of this requirement will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

FINISH:

- The Finish is on the A53 at the northern end of the lay-by some 1.83 miles from Shawbury corner (junction of the A53 and the B5063). It will be indicated by a checkerboard sign.
- Please call out your number as you cross the Finish line.
- Competitors on finishing **MUST NOT** stop at the finish. Please continue to HQ.

RESULTS & HQ REFRESHMENTS

Results will be displayed at HQ as and when they are received. Competitors are reminded to return their numbers to the signing in desk and sign out. Hot drinks and various snacks will be on sale. These are provided by the Ladies of the local church and all proceeds go to the church. Please note that some of the snacks may contain traces of nuts.

DRINKS:


- The drinks station will not operate this year.
- Riders who have support may be handed drinks at any **SAFE** place on the course, subject to CTT regulations regarding following cars. The form for registering following cars will be available at HQ.
- All litter and rubbish must be collected afterwards.

SAFETY

- CTT Regulations stipulate that all riders must wear a helmet.
- A working front light is mandatory as is a rear light. No competitor shall be permitted to start unless they comply with these requirements.
- All riders must obey the rules of the road and not indulge in any dangerous manoeuvres ANYWHERE ON THE COURSE. Riders are reminded to ride with heads up. You are provided with high visibility race numbers and you should wear them in accordance with Regulation 16 for your own safety. Please wear your arm number on your LEFT arm.
- **PROSCRIBED SUBSTANCES:** Please note that, more and more events are being attended by UKAD and riders tested for proscribed substances. The Anfield Bicycle Club fully support UKAD and do not tolerate the use of proscribed substances. Should the event be subject to Dope Control, it is up to you to check whether or not you are required to provide a sample. The race number of those selected for testing will be displayed at Event HQ.




