#### **STARTSHEET**

BJW was formed in 1935, the Jubilee Year of King George V. The first official 25 was held in 1936 and won by Stan Hullett (1.09.20). From 1940 to 1945 events were not run due to the outbreak of war as many members were conscripted to fight or required to support in the war effort. Events resumed in 1947 and we have been running an open 25 every year since.

## **Timekeepers**

### **Headquarters**

Event HQ and parking will be at Lytchett Matravers village hall, BH16 6DF (Blanchard room – at back of main hall). Collection of race numbers will be stationed outside the hall, please bring your own pen, report to HQ to collect race numbers and sign on prior to the event, please remember that you are now required to personally return your number and sign out. One male and one female toilet will be open, these are to be used on a one in one out basis. No refreshments are available unfortunately.

SAFE ROUTE TO START - Right out of HQ, then right down Wareham Road SAFE ROUTE FROM FINISH - Continue to Organford T-junction where right to cross the A35 WITH CARE then continue up Wareham Road, left into the High Street. (Do not stop at the finish – return to HQ)

### **Course P413/25**

**Start** at drain cover in acceleration lane to a35 - 85 yards east of pikes farm junction (os sy939931) proceed east on a35 to bakers arms roundabout (1.02m). straight on along a35 to turn at holes bay roundabout (4.59m). Circle and retrace to turn at bakers arms roundabout (8.18m). lap 2: circle and retrace on a35 to turn at holes bay roundabout (11.81m). circle and retrace to turn at bakers arms roundabout (15.40m). lap 3: circle and retrace on a35/a350 to turn at holes bay roundabout (19.03m) circle and retrace to bakers arms roundabout (22.61m). then take first exit left onto a351 to turn at holton heath roundabout (23.58m). circle and retrace to bakers arms roundabout (24.58m). left on a35 then shortly fork left (signposted to organford) on minor road to finish at electricity sub station (os 947925)

**Poole Fire station Emergency Traffic Lights are in operation at the Holes Bay Roundabout.** An observer will be present and any rider going through a red light will be disqualified. When approaching **Bakers Arms roundabout**, competitors must keep to the left until they have passed the "Reduce Speed Now" sign on the left, approximately 400m before the roundabout. Observers will be present and offending competitors will be disqualified from the event for dangerous or inconsiderate riding.

No U turns within sight of the start or finish. No warming up on the course after the event has started. No stopping or turning within sight of the finish, return WITH CARE to HQ.

#### IN THE INTEREST OF YOUR OWN SAFETY

Cycling Time Trails and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD-SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard-Shell Helmets.

In accordance with Regulation 14 h) i) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

You must avoid riding with your head down. Even on a Clearway, cars may stop for a variety of reasons, and the responsibility for avoiding them rests with the rider. In the event of a collision, the fact that the car was contravening the Clearway regulations will not be an excuse. A rider can expect a suspension from competition for any failure to watch where they are going.

## Please note the following:

- Free parking is available at the HQ, there is a height barrier. Larger vehicles could park in the smaller car park opposite the shops.
- Competitors should not attend if they feel ill in ANY way or if family members have any symptoms. If you feel ill during the warmup you should not start the event and leave immediately.
- Static warm-ups are ok within the car park, please keep noise to a minimum as its early in the morning.
- Competitors on finishing MUST NOT stop at the finish, MUST NOT loiter at the HQ/car park and MUST pack away and leave upon completion of the race.
- No support can be provided if a competitor suffers mechanical difficulties. It is strongly advised

that all competitors carry with them a spare inner-tube/tubular, pump and tyre levers if required.

- It is strongly advised that all competitors carry a mobile phone and take with them the telephone number of the event organiser. Please telephone the organiser if you have failed to finish the event.
- Riders are expected to know the course and should not rely on the marshals for directions
- Please be aware that when entering the Bakers Arms Rbt from the start there will be riders already on the course taking their second or third laps, please keep your <u>heads up and eyes open</u> for other riders on the course.
