HQ	Falfield Village Hall, Falfield, GL12 8DH. The hall will be open from 08:00. There is some parking available at the hall. Where parking on public roads please be mindful of local residents and ensure you are parked legally.
COVID-19 matters	While there is no longer any government guidance on covid the UK is experiencing the highest rate of infection so far. To avoid aggravating the situation and possible damage to training plans we are asking everyone at this event to act responsibly by wearing a mask if possible and maintaining social distancing. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If weather allows, sign on may be done outside• We suggest you wear masks in indoor places and use hand sanitizer• We will provide drinks and cakes at the end of the event
Signing on and off	Riders must sign on at race HQ to collect their number and check for any last minute information regarding the event or course. You must sign out of the event after completing your ride, and return your race number. Failure to sign-on AND sign-off will result in DNF recorded on your result
Course notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not warm up on the course once the event has started• Avoid making U-turns near to the start or finish of the course. Riders failing to follow this instruction may be disqualified. After crossing the finish line proceed back to HQ along the course route and turn left onto the unnamed road highlighted in the map, being mindful of other riders who may still be competing - do not stop and continue to make progress after the finish line• The turn off the A38 onto the minor road to begin the first and second circuit is sharp - take care and ensure you remain on the left hand side of the centre line• The course passes through several villages, including Newport, Breadstone and Wanswell which may have parked cars and pedestrians on the course. Please take extra care on these parts of the course, especially at the T-junction Wanswell where you must look in both directions as cars may be approaching from the left on your side of the road• The road surface is broken in several parts of the course, including the A38. Take care and keep your head up.
Safety	Riders are asked to take care while riding the course, and in particular note the following points: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The race takes place on public roads with live traffic on the course - competitors must obey the highway code at all times and not impede other road users• There are marshals located at each of the turns on the course to help indicate direction only, it is the competitor's responsibility to give way to any traffic with right of way at any time on the course• All bikes must be fitted with working front and rear lights - anyone who does not have one will not be allowed to start the event• All riders MUST wear protective hard shell helmets• If the weather is bad with poor visibility or other conditions which present a danger to riders the event may be delayed or postponed• Please keep your head up for a safe ride
Course details	START At the splay at the northern end of the bus stop at Woodford (GR690958). FIRST CIRCUIT Head north on the A38 to Berkeley Road (GR717001), turn left onto minor road before railway bridge (4.01miles). Continue to the T-junction in Wanswell, turn left. Continue to roundabout with B4066, turn left. Continue on B4066 to next roundabout where turn left again, towards the A38 at Berkeley Heath (10.41 miles). Turn left onto A38, and continue north on the A38 to the Berkeley Road junction. SECOND CIRCUIT Repeat the circuit again, back to the A38 at Berkeley Heath (16.81 miles). Turn left onto A38 again, this time continuing north on the A38 (ignoring the Berkeley Road junction this time) to the Slimbridge roundabout. Circle roundabout and return south on the A38 FINISH At the second drain cover past Catherine Villa (white house next to garage) (GR684949) (25 miles). Please SHOUT your number as your cross the finishing line for the final time

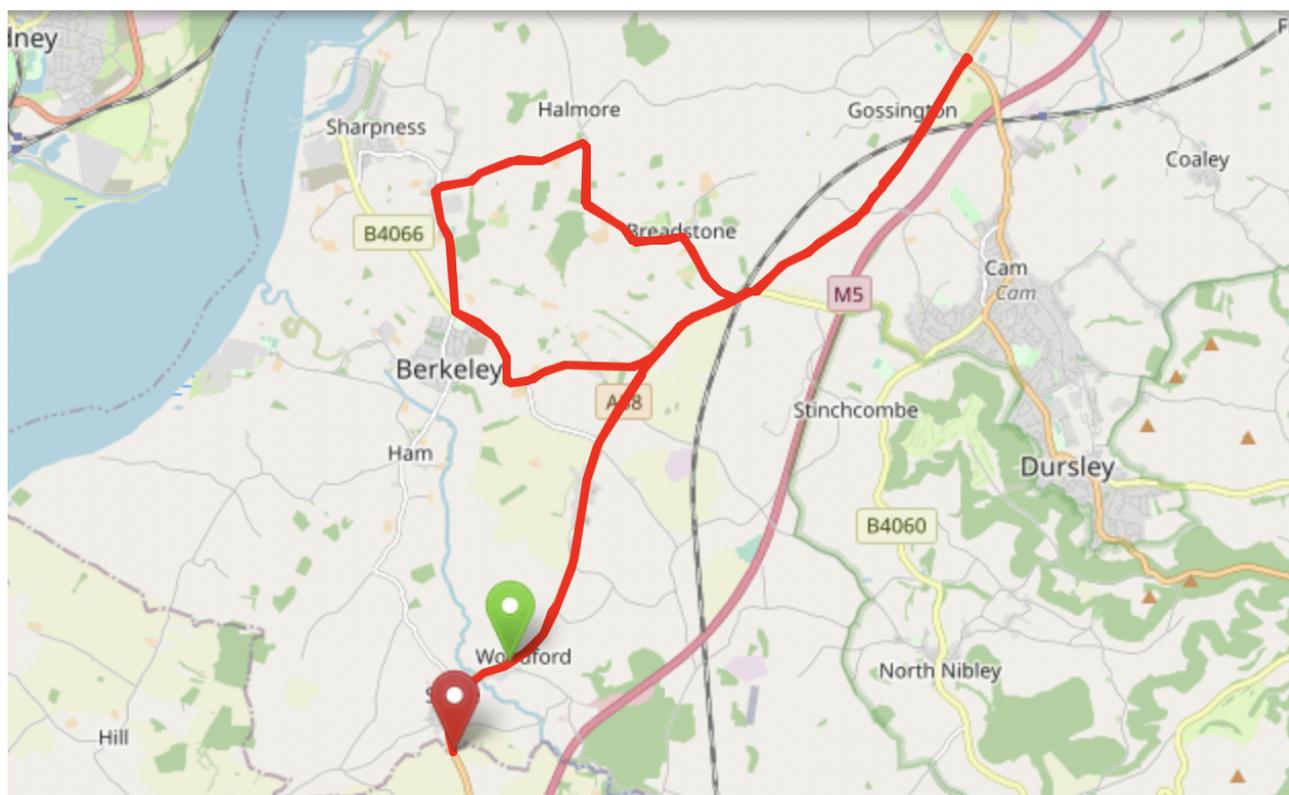

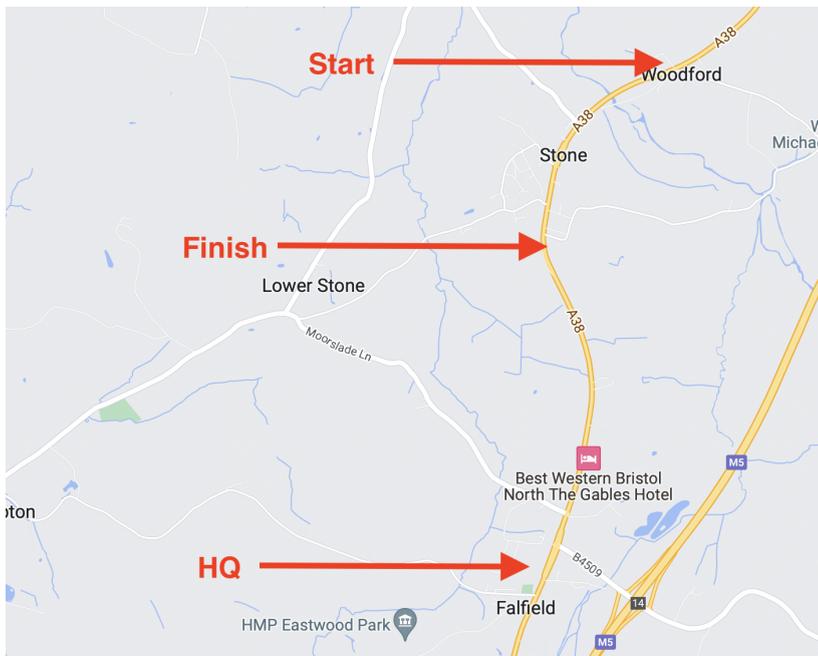

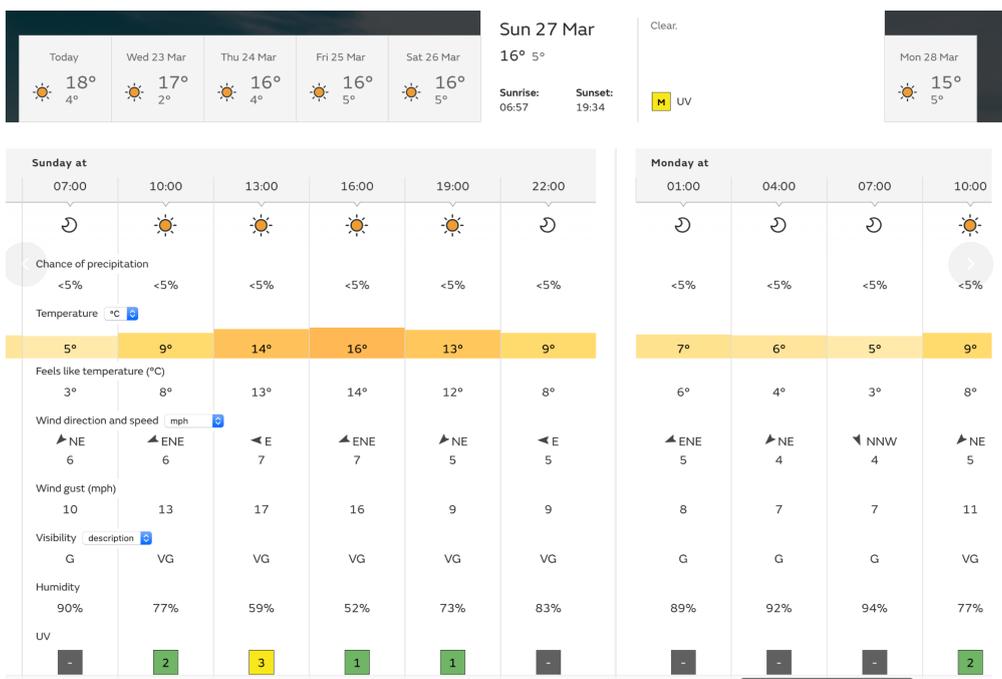
