

	Turn left & continue to the junction with M40(J5). Turn right just before bridge over M40 (M2) onto old A40.		
	Proceed to junction with minor road to Christmas Common. (M3)	5	
	Turn left & continue through Christmas Common to junction with B480. (M4)	8.5	
	Turn right and immediately left (M5) onto the B481. Proceed via Cookley Green to Nettlebed. (M6)	12.7	
	Turn left onto A4130. Straight on at roundabout to junction with the A4155 at Henley. (M7)	18	
	Turn left & continue through Medmenham to Marlow. (M8)	25	
	At Ford garage turn left up Oxford Road and continue uphill to Frieth crossroads. (M9)	29	
	Turn left to FINISH near Frieth Village Hall.	29.50
