COURSE DESCRIPTION: SWIDECOMBE

<u>START:</u> on B3387 just past the last house on the left (Mill House) when leaving the village (east bound), at the first tree on the left by the farm gate and just short of the 20% gradient sign. Proceed east on the B3387 to climb to the top of the hill.

<u>FINISH</u>: at the entrance to the car park at the summit of the hill on the left-hand side of the road.

RIDERS PLEASE TAKE NOTE

DIRECTIONS TO START From HQ: Turn left on leaving the car park. Please allow 2 minutes to ride to the start.

<u>TOILETS:</u> At HQ, Widecombe car park. Further public toilets are available in Haytor Lower Car Park.

NUMBERS: Numbers to be collected at the event HQ.

After finishing riders should retrace their steps to HQ, and sign back in. Please control your speed and do not obstruct other riders on the course.

<u>SAFETY</u>

<u>Riders be warned:</u> Dangerous riding causes accidents & could endanger the future of the sport. Please ride with your head up at all times and observe the Highway Code. Give way or stop when required. Observe CTT regulations. Mobile and stationary observers have been appointed. They will act if riders are seen in contravention of CTT regulations or Highway Code. In poor visibility lights should be fitted and conspicuous clothing worn.

Event Officials: Must not seek to regulate or interfere with other traffic.
