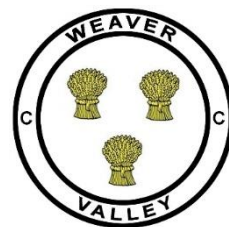

J2/21 Course details (course map included below)

Start

- 0.0 miles LOWER WITHINGTON**
On the B5392 Salters Lane at the leading edge of the rainwater grid located at the far end of the Lay-by opposite Lower Withington Methodist Church. Proceed West to T-Junction with A535 at...
- 1.037 miles JODRELL BANK**
Turn left with care on to A535 & proceed to roundabout in Holmes Chapel at...
- 3.955 miles MANOR LANE**
Turn left into Manor Lane and at next roundabout take 1st exit to...
- 4.279 miles A54**
Proceed along A54 to...
- 8.543 miles LOACH BROOK ROUNDABOUT**
Take 1st exit along Congleton By-pass to...
- 9.571 miles RADNOR ROUNDABOUT**
Encircle roundabout and retrace to...
- 10.652 miles LOACH BROOK ROUNDABOUT**
Take 3rd exit to A54 and retrace to Roundabout in Holmes Chapel at...
- 14.964 miles MANOR LANE**
Take 2nd exit into Manor Lane and at next island take 3rd exit to...

15.301 miles A535

Proceed along A535 to...

21.167 miles CHELFORD ISLAND

Encircle Island and proceed along A535 to turn left **(Extreme caution)** at...

24.149 miles FARM LANE

Proceed along lane (changes to Salters Lane after about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile) to...

25.000 miles FINISH

Adjacent to boundary of Nos 3 & 4 Salters Lane (Terrace named South View).

NOTES AND LOCAL REGULATIONS

This is the first event on this course. The Risk Assessment document will be available at the signing-on desk, but we highly recommend you read it, in advance, on the CTT District website <https://www.cyclingtimetrials.org.uk/course-details/j2-21>

CARE AT ROAD JUNCTIONS

Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

CHELFORD ISLAND

Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Regulation 20, and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders **MUST NOT USE** their tri-bars between the first bollard they pass on entering the island and the last bollard they pass leaving it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

SAFE RIDING

Riding with your head down such that you do not have a good view of the road ahead is dangerous - please watch out for potholes, obstacles, and other road users.

Marshalls do not have the authority to control other road users, so please take care.

START AND FINISH

No “U” turns in the vicinity of the start or finish.

Riders must not stop at the finish but should instead continue back to the headquarters.

VEHICLES

A competitor must not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in any way receive assistance from a motorised vehicle or its occupants during events shorter than 100km (CTT Regulation 22).

No parking for riders or spectators at the start or finish. This is both for the safety of riders at the start, and because of limited space.

Parking is available at the headquarters, please be considerate towards local residents.

OTHER NOTES

Road bike category:

The following requirements are for the purposes of the road bike prize eligibility only -

Road bikes will be checked at the start for compliance -

- The bike can possess drop or straight handlebars.
- No tribars, clip-on bars or Spinacci bars are allowed.
- No disc wheels.
- Both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each.
- The maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm.
- Helmets used in Road Bike category events must not cover the ears or have a teardrop/pointy style “tail”, any helmet vents must not be covered or blocked. The helmet must not have been altered or had any element added or removed in terms of design or form but may be used as the manufacturer's intended (e.g., sliding vents). It is prohibited to add a detachable cover to a helmet. The composition of the helmet material and its surface condition are not subject to any regulations. However, additions to the helmet are not allowed (cover, tape etc).
- Competitors must predominantly ride holding the drops or brake hoods. Riders may not ride in the “Puppy Paws” Position or simulate a Tri-Bar position by resting the forearms on the handlebars.

A competitor overtaking another must pass without receiving or giving shelter. The onus of avoiding company riding shall be upon the rider overtaken. (CTT Regulation 21).

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY

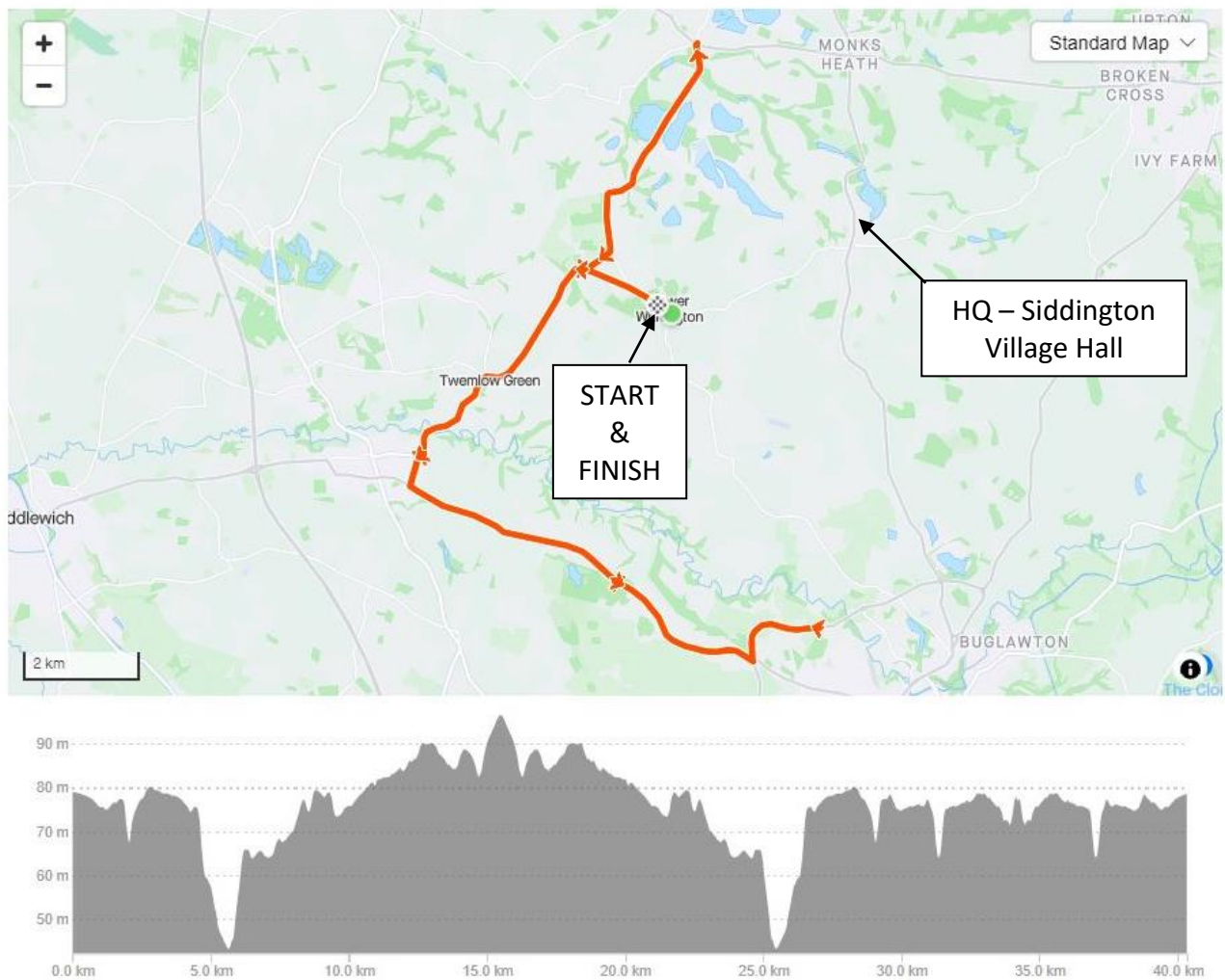
HELMETS - CTT Regulation 15

All competitors MUST wear a properly affixed helmet of hard/soft shell construction that meets international standards.

FRONT AND REAR LIGHT - CTT Regulation 14(j)

No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, and to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, each of which shall be either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.
