START (GR 518369) on B1383 at green paint mark at Gully cover 20 yds S. of bend sign which is N. of Bus lay-by opposite road to Saffron Walden & N. of fighting Cocks PH. Approx 1.5miles N. of Newport. Proceed north through Littlebury and Gt. Chesterford to turn (5.1m) at roundabout at junction of B1383/A1301. Retrace along B1383 through Great Chesterford and Littlebury to FINISH (GR 518369) at Green paint mark at gully cover just S of white direction board approx 50yds S of start point.

Keep your heads up and enjoy your ride!
