NOTES TO COMPETITORS

PARKING: There is parking at the HQ. Additional parking is available on the hard standing at Prees Heath, SY13 3JT, just 0.9 miles from the HQ and aa short distance from the finish.

Please note CTT regulations requiring a working front as well as rear light and the compulsory use of helmets for all competitors: In accordance with Regulation 14(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

In accordance with Regulation 14(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users in accordance with Regulation 15 - All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction.

Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard. There will be a separate start line official checking compliance with the regulations. Any competitor not in compliance will not be allowed to start.

AT NO TIME SHOULD RIDERS PERFORM U-TURNS IN THE ROAD – Local District Regulations prohibit U turns in the vicinity of the Start and Finish and any rider observed infringing this rule will be disqualified.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR HEAD UP AT ALL TIMES – riding head down is dangerous and causes accidents.

NUMBERS: Will be at the HQ an hour before the first start. You must sign-in asap after completing your race.

WARM UP – Please do not warm up on the course.

NOTE – There is a pedestrian crossing in the village of Hadnall. If the lights are on red then riders must stop until the lights change. An observer will be present to verify. Non-compliance = Disqualification

SPECTATORS AND VEHICLES: There is no space for spectators or their cars near the start and finish. Riders must not be followed while on course. This will result in disqualification and the rider being reported to CTT.

RETURN TO HQ: Return your number and sign-out. We plan to offer refreshments at the HQ.

RESULTS: We will aim to inform you of your result at HQ. Please do not bother timekeepers at the start or finish or obstruct their view. Prize presentation will take place as soon as possible after the end of the event. If you are a medal winner, make yourself known to one of the officials.


COURSE INFORMATION

What3words

HQ: <u>fans.name.handlebar</u>

Start: <u>fortunate.belief.recording</u>

Finish: lunch.eagle.masterful



Directions to Start (3.5 mile allow 15 minutes)

- Turn left out of HQ and proceed for 0.9mile along lane to T junction (mind there are a few potholes).
- Turn right and proceed straight to take a right to join the A49.
- Proceed along the A49 for 2.5mile to arrive at start (see map below)



D25/20

- Start on A49, 5.5 miles south of Whitchurch, Shropshire, at the southern end of the bridge
- on Prees Bypass.
- Proceed south along the A49 to turn at Battlefield Church Island (first island) - 11.3 miles.
- Encircle Island with care and retrace along the A49, past the start, to
- Finish approx 400 yards short of Prees Island, at telegraph pole 50 yards past Shamrock
- Lodge and 12 yards before the "Slippery Road Surface" sign.
