The Course Q10/19

Start on A.26 one mile south of Tonbridge, at kerb point 50 yards north of Mabelton and 10 feet past 40 mph limit signs (TQ580445). Proceed north and take first left to join A21 (M). Proceed on A.21, left on slip road (M) to Weald RAB using the left hand side of the carriageway. (5.4 miles). Encircle and retrace on A.21 (M) to finish at the leading edge of the last bridge before the A.26 slip road (TQ575451).

It is your responsibility to ensure you have familiarised yourself with the course prior to start

Headquarters

Event HQ is Weald of Kent Grammar School, Tudeley Lane, Tonbridge, Kent, TN9 2JP.



Directions to start from Event HQ: -

Turn left out of Event HQ onto Tudeley Lane then right onto A2014 Pembury Road. Take the first exit at the roundabout and proceed south up the A26 Quarry Hill Road. After passing over the A21 the start line will be on your right.

Please allow 10 minutes to ride from event HQ to the start line

NOTES FOR RIDERS

Numbers will be in the event headquarters hall and will be personally issued to each rider after they have signed on. Riders should refer to Regulation 16 on page 342 of the 2017 National Handbook- which states that *'the number should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in the normal riding position'*.

Please note that all competitors are required personally to sign the signing out sheet when re-turning their number.

Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

Please keep noise to a minimum to avoid unnecessary disturbance of local residents.

Please remove racing shoes before entering the hall.

Do Not perform U turns in the start and finishing areas and do not use these areas as a public toilet as offenders risk disqualification.

Strictly **NO PARKING** for riders or supporters on the A26 London Road except for the timekeeper and the pushers-off. A boot fair may be scheduled in the field opposite the start creating extra traffic and the lay-by at the field entrance will be coned off and out of bounds.

Riders should not arrive at the start more than 5 minutes before their allotted start time and must not congregate in the private driveway immediately south of the start.

Riders proven to be associated with any car parking or turning in this vicinity will be disqualified from the event

All Junior/Juvenile riders MUST wear recognised standard protective headgear. In the interests of safety it is recommended that **all riders** should wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

It is also recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to your machine in a position visible to following road users & is active whilst the machine is in use.

Whilst competing riders must ensure they adhere to the Highway Regulations and CTT Rules and Regulations as disciplinary action may result from any breaches of these regulations. Riders must also ensure their helpers comply with the Regulations relating to vehicles.
