Safety Instructions and Regulations

- If you feel at all unwell or are showing signs of Covid 19 DO NOT come to this event.
- CTT regulations require the use of a helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards for all competitors
- CTT Regulations now require that no competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a **working rear red light**, and to the front of their machine a **working front white light**, either flashing or constant, that are illuminated and positioned to be clearly visible to other road users
- London South DC strongly recommend that riders do not wear black or dark clothing during any event held on the public road
- Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first rider has started.
- No Vehicles, except those of the Timekeepers' and Event Officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start and finish areas
- Competitors must not use ANY audio equipment except prescribed hearing aids. A competitor in breach of this regulation shall be disqualified.
- NB Competitors must not use a mobile phone while mounted on their machines.
- No time may be recorded if number is not correctly positioned
- Official Observers will be stationed around the course
- Under 18 age entries must bring a completed parental consent form with them, present these "before signing on". No parental consent, then no ride.

Event Specific Instructions

- Due to the large number of novice riders in this event with no prior times to assist with seeding, riders attention is drawn to the regulations that govern Time Trials and prohibits drafting (riding in company).
- There will be toilet facilities but these are not to be used as changing rooms.
- PLEASE KEEP NOISE TO A MINIMUM FOR RESIDENTS AND RESPECT PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Course

This event is held in the London South District, on 13.58 mile circuit course **GS/292A**
Hungry Hill Lane > East Clandon > West Horsley > Ripley Lane
2 laps, 13.58 miles total. Course details as follows:

START in Hungry Hill Lane at TP7, 114 yards south of junction with Rose Lane and about 0.8 miles southeast of Ripley	0.00	0.00
Proceed along Hungry Hill Lane and Ripley Road to East Clandon, where LEFT into The Street. Follow road round a sharp right-hand bend (now New Road) to junction with A246	3.12	3.12
LEFT and follow A246 to West Horsley RBT (roundabout)	1.15	4.27
LEFT 1st exit into The Street and, after 1/4 mile, fork LEFT into Ripley Lane. Continue into Rose Lane to junction with Hungry Hill Lane. LEFT into Hungry Hill Lane to complete first circuit at starting point.	2.61	6.88
Second circuit follows same route to FINISH at south side of pair of wooden gates 194 yards before the junction of Rose Lane with Hungry Hill Lane	6.70	13.58

Road bike category rules

1. No aerobars, clip on aerobars or aero extensions can be used
2. Hands must be holding the handlebars at all times whilst racing (i.e. not with forearms resting on the handlebar)
3. Wheels must have a minimum of 12 spokes each, and have a maximum rim depth of 90mm
4. Helmets must have no visor
5. Ears must not be covered by the helmet (Giro Aerohead helmets, for example, are not permitted)
