
Cranbrook CC 10 mile Time Trial

The venue will be open from 6:00 am and the first rider will set off at 7:01 am. Car parking is available at the HQ. Please park with consideration for other users, without excessive space between cars and do not block any accesses

Course Details

Riders are to ensure they are familiar with the course before starting the event. Note this course includes give way junctions, which must be respected at all times

Route from HQ to start: Turn right onto the road outside HQ and head south to the T-junction at Fenny Bridges. Turn right signed Exeter & Fairmile and proceed for 1 mile to the layby on the opposite side of the road. The start is in this layby.

- 1. Start in the layby and proceed east through Fenny Bridges, under Iron Bridge and merge with the A30.
- 2. Continue east along the A30 for approximately 3.3 miles, then take the exit signed for Poole, Dorchester & Honiton
- 3. Follow the carousel round and over the A30 before (caution: give way) turning right to rejoin the A30 westbound for approximately 3.3 miles
- 4. Take the exit signed Ottery St Mary, Fairmile, Feniton then (caution: give way) then turn left at the T junction and proceed westbound back through Fenny Bridges
- 5. Finish at the crest of the hill, just before the start layby

Important Notes

- Front and rear lights are compulsory
- Hard shell helmets are compulsory
- Riders must sign in and out when collecting and returning numbers
