Course description: Start on A614 at Lamp Post No. 08209 near metal gate at southern end of Hatfield Woodhouse. Proceed southwards on A614 to Blaxton T1 (5.026 miles). Encircle island and retrace along A614 to finish at LP No. 08212 at northern corner of triangle at end of Ancient Lane (10 miles).

Please note that the turn is quite tight - don't approach too fast!

No parking by competitors or their helpers anywhere on Ancient Lane, or in Hatfield Woodhouse Village - adequate parking available at the Village Hall.

No warming up on the course after race start. No U turns in sight of the start or Finish

No stopping at the finish, please continue straight back towards the HQ

Numbers and signing on/off sheets will be available at the event HQ prior to the event. Keep your heads up while riding and obey the rules of the road. Remember that marshals are **not** there to stop the traffic or advise you whether it is clear. Take responsibility for your own riding at all times. **The road surface on the course is poor in places with sunken drain covers.**

There are minor junctions off the main road so be aware of the traffic around you.

ALL PARKING AT THE HQ. PLEASE RESPECT THE RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAGE.

Cycling Time Trials require that you wear a **HARD SHELL HELMET** that meets approved safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15

YOUR CYCLE MUST HAVE A WORKING FRONT and REAR LIGHT FITTED, NO LIGHTS NO RIDE!

If in doubt about your bike, helmet or clothing and position, then see CTT regs 14, 15 and 16. These regulations will apply on the day.

Road bike specification - we are using the CTT road bike description.

This event may be subject to doping control

Race numbers required for doping control will be displayed.

Remember to return your number and sign out after you have finished - or its DNF!

National 10 Mile Championship Awards

Results on Standard are measured by “Age Adjusted Time (AAT)”

All VTTA awards are made regardless of the number of entries and irrespective of any prizes given by the promoting Group.

Solo awards

1st on AAT overall: Ken Matthews Cup

1st Open on AAT: National Men’s Champion title,

Gold Medal and Championship Jersey +£40

2nd Open on AAT: Silver Medal +£30

3rd Open on AAT: Bronze Medal +£20

1st Female on AAT: National Women’s Champion title,

Gold Medal and Championship Jersey +£40

2nd Female on AAT : Silver Medal +£30

3rd Female on AAT: Bronze Medal +£20

Club teams shall consist of three first claim members of the same club.£20 each

Group teams shall consist of three members of the same Group. £20 each.

In each case, the team with the best result on AAT shall be the

Championship Team and a medal will be awarded to each

member of the team.

Tandem awards. The pair with the best result on AAT will be the

Tandem Champions and will receive VTTA gold medals. 1st £20 each.

Fastest rider on the day. Open - £25. Female - £25

Fastest road bike - 1st - £25. 2nd - £20.

Note on eligibility

To be eligible for Championship awards, riders must be paid- up VTTA members at the closing date for entries and have linked online VTTA and CTT accounts (so their membership can be automatically verified).

Riders who are aged 39, but who will be aged 40 by the day of the Championship, may apply to the Championship organiser to be included on condition that they will have completed an online membership application prior to the day of the championship which the organiser can check.
