## **Course details**

The event will take place on the U21/10 course. [Cycling Time Trials: Course Code: U21/10](#)

Start on A371 Cross Lane at the junction with Prowse's Lane heading towards the A38. Turn left at the A38 junction. **You must give way to traffic coming down the A38.** This is your responsibility. Marshalls have been specifically instructed to not indicate if the turn is clear.

Follow the A38 over the M5 bridge and take a U turn (3<sup>rd</sup> exit) round the roundabout where the A38 meets the A370.

Return on the A38 finishing east of the Old River Axe ([what3words ///burden.invite.incurs](#)).

**The A38 surface is rough, rutted and potholed in places. Please ride with caution.** You must follow the highway code and ride safely at all times. Do not exceed speed restrictions.

### **Event HQ, parking and sign-on**

The event HQ is Cross Memorial Hall, Webbington Road, Cross Somerset BS26 2EL. HQ will be open from 7.30am. Please bring some cash for refreshments.

There is no car park at the HQ although there is lots of parking available roadside through the village. **This is a residential area, please be considerate regarding noise and do not use turbos etc around residents' houses.**

### **Strictly no parking immediately outside HQ**

There are 2 car parks outside of the village that are more suitable if you want to warm up with a view. Axbridge picnic area off the A371(W3W ///quite.extensive.kick) and Webbington Road viewpoint and car park (W3W ///prone.ventures.treaty).

### **Please do not warm up on the course once racing is underway (08:30)**

Do not arrive at the start more than 5 minutes before your allotted time.

### **Sign on**

The HQ will be open for sign on from 07.30.

If you are new to time trialling, note that all competitors need to collect their number and 'sign-on' at the event HQ prior to racing as well as return their number and 'sign-out' after they have finished.

### **Race information**

All competitors must wear helmets. All competitors must have a working front and rear lights. **You will not be permitted to start without a helmet or working lights.**

### **Road bike category**

No tri-bars. No disc wheels. Front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes and maximum rim depth of 90mm. Helmets must not cover the ears or have a tear drop/pointy tail.

### **Finish and results**

**Please remember to return your number and sign-out once you have finished.** There will be a provisional results board displayed in the HQ area, and prizes will be handed out as soon as possible following the conclusion of racing.
