## **SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

- CTT Regulations now require that no competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, and to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that are illuminated and positioned to be clearly visible to other road users.
- Official Observers will be stationed around the course. Traffic awareness remains the responsibility of the competitor.
- CTT regulations require the use of a helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards for all competitors.
- Competitors must not use ANY audio equipment except prescribed hearing aids.
- London South DC strongly recommend that riders do not wear black or dark clothing during any event held on the public road
- No Vehicles, except those of the Timekeepers' and Event Officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start and finish areas
- Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first competitor has started. There is plenty of space at the HQ for turbos.
- Details of any additional hazards not listed on the start sheet will be displayed or advised at the Signing On point. All competitors must take note of these details when they sign on.
- Numbers will be available in the HQ from 1300 when it opens.
- Bags may be left in the HQ at owners' risk.
- Competitors must exercise extra care when joining the A24 at Kingsfold and at all roundabouts.
- No times will be given at the finish. Please do not U turn in the road after the finish- continue down to the next left hand junction.
- Any participants under the age of 18 are required to present their completed parental consent form at the sign-on desk. No helmet, no parental consent then no ride.
- Please be courteous when overtaking other riders. A bit of friendly encouragement goes a long way!

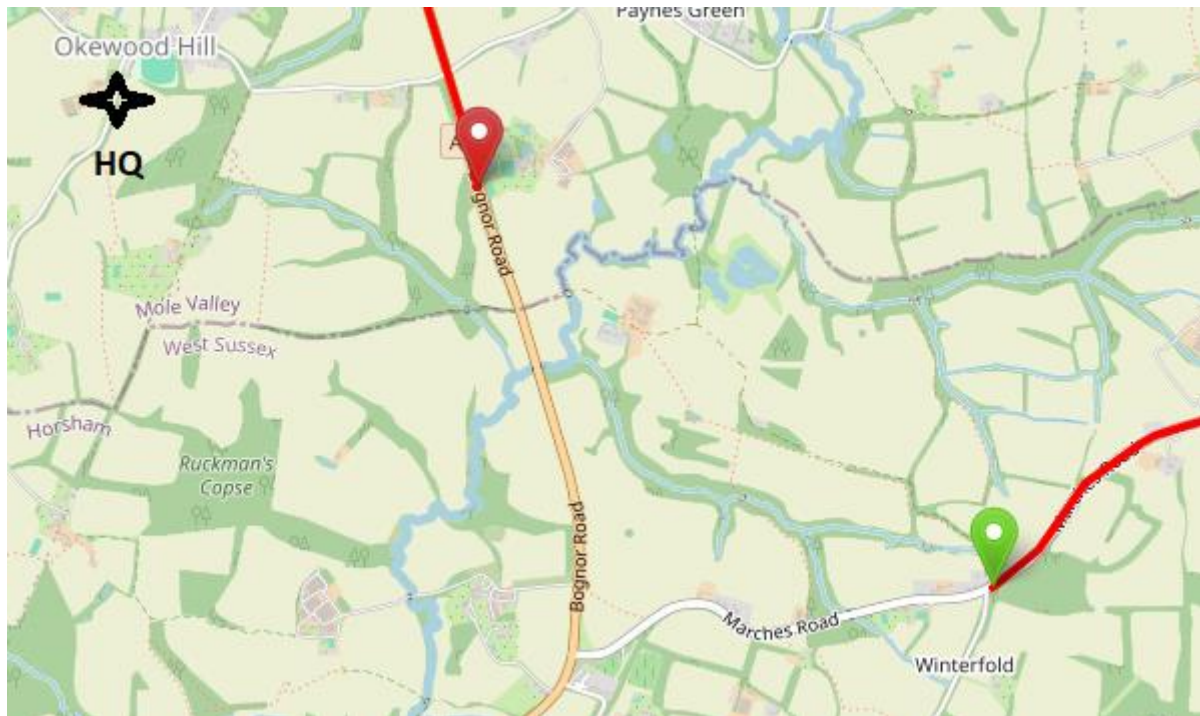

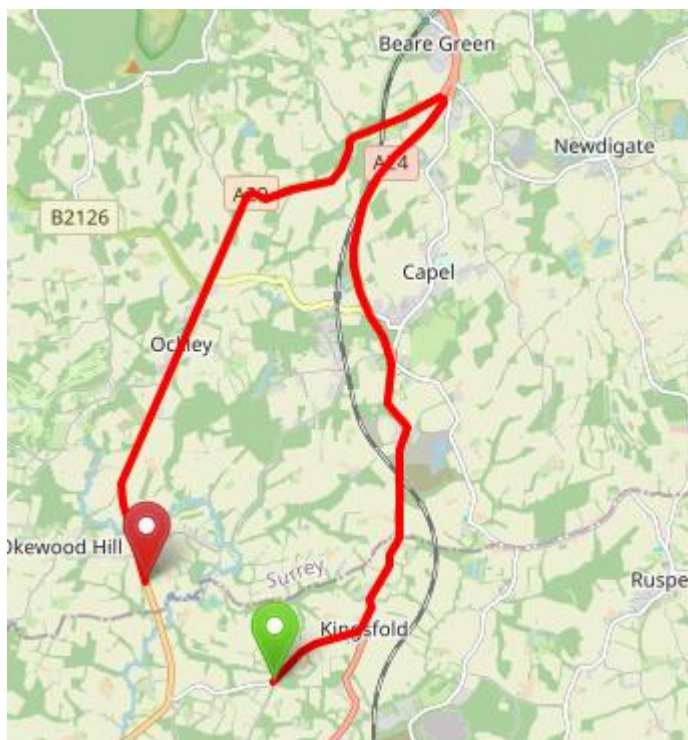

### Start, Finish and HQ

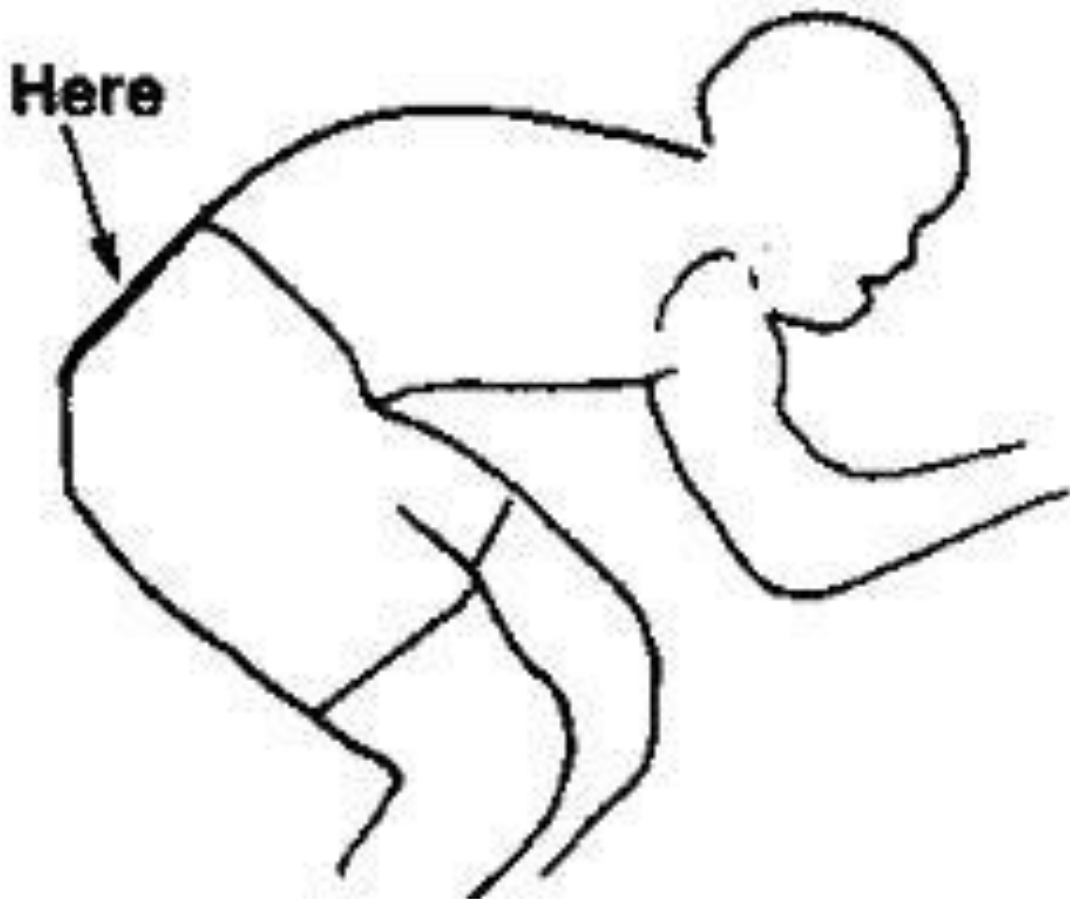


### Full course
