Banbury Star Cyclists' Club Open 23 Mile "HARDRIDERS" Time Trial

<u>Promoted for and on behalf of Cycling Time Trials under their Rules and Regulations</u>

To be held on the K4/23 Course on Sunday the 27th of June 2021. First Rider off at **0802hrs**.

Welcome to this challenging event in an unusual spot on the calendar after its postponement from its usual Spring date due to the dreaded C word.

Regrettably, due to the current social distancing requirements and such like, we are running a slightly basic event this season with no catering or prize gathering, so please bring your own refreshments. As your entry fees are unchanged, we will be offering spot prizes to make up for that.

Results will be noted at the event station where you sign on and off and will be published promptly after the event by email and online thereafter.

Please take care on Sunrising Hill, which is known to be steep and sometimes slippery with a tight left hand bend on the way down. Also, take care through Ettington village. CAUTION!

(2) Timekeepers and Marshals

Race marshals do not need to go to the HQ unless collecting a high viz vest. The role of the marshals is only to notify riders which way to turn at junctions and to ensure high visibility on course.

(3) Awards

As it is often only the winners who walk away with an award at the end of the day despite the fact that everyone puts in their maximum effort, it seems reasonable to be a little creative with our prizes.

The first, second and third man and woman will each win £40, £30 or £20 in that order.

Other 'awards' will then be given on a pre-determined basis to those riders finishing on a ten, even if they didn't start on one! So, if you are lucky enough to finish 10th, 20th, 30th, 40th or 50th, then you are in luck and will take home £10. One prize only. Prizes move down a place if required.

We would usually reward juniors in the same way as the leading men and women, but as we only have one junior in the event, that is not practical this time around regrettably.

All prizes winners will be contacted for their details after the results have been published so that their winnings can be transferred directly to them (Paypal preferred).

There is limited parking and there are toilets at the Club. Please park responsibly and if you are a local rider then please ride to the event so that those from further afield can park.


Race HQ will be open from 0700hrs for signing on and will close after all riders are signed out, likely at around 0945hrs.

It is essential that social distancing and the "rule of 6" is maintained at the HQ at all times, You must keep a 2m distance in all directions from all other competitors and officials.

There must be no group gatherings at the car park or elsewhere please. Please, when you arrive, collect your number and then leave the area. This is vital to comply with regulations and to protect the image of our club and our sport.

From the HQ, turn right to the disused pub a hundred or so metres away. Proceed WNW to Ettington roundabout and return to the edge of Wroxton Village, finishing just after the village welcome signs.

Marshals will be on course to provide visibility, but do TAKE CARE, especially on Sunrising Hill and in Ettington village where one or two sleepy heads may be going for their Sunday paper.

SOCIAL DISTANCING AT THE START IS ESSENTIAL. SPITTING ANYWHERE NEAR THE START WILL LEAD TO DISQUALIFICATION.

(6) NOTES & CAUTIONS

REMEMBER to sign out after the event and return your number.

DO NOT use turbo trainers in the vicinity of residential properties please. We don't like complaints from the public.

WORKING REAR LIGHTS ARE MANDATORY AT THE START LINE. Please see the CTT Guidance Note in case you are not familiar with the rule. I will not permit you to start unless you have a working rear light at that moment.

No vehicles other than those of the timekeeper and marshals may park in the vicinity of the finish. DO NOT pass the start after the event has started.

DO NOT stop at the finish. Please carry on to the HQ where your result will be posted reasonably promptly.
