COVID-19 CTT INSTRUCTIONS

Do not attend if you/your family members feel ill.

Though the Covid-19 Protocols have been dropped by the Party-Party Government, please show courtesy to fellow riders & crew i.e. be considerate with any affectionate greetings. Please be sensible about social distancing, we will keep the doors open at the HQ to allow circulation of fresh air.

There will be no pusher-offered; you will have to do a standing start on your own (one foot on the ground). Rolling starts will not be permitted.

Once you have finished your race you will be asked to return your number & sign out, back at the HQ.

Parking – Please use the free car park at the Village Hall and overspill in the field, be aware this is a residential area and many will (sensibly!) still be in their beds, so please keep the noise levels down, no noisy turbo's please. **No parking in the vicinity of Greatham Church.**

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. It is also compulsory that WORKING FRONT & REAR LIGHTS, either flashing or constant, are fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use

Course Description P884b/30

Start on the Hard Shoulder on the southbound slip road to the A3 at Longmoor (A325) three metres from the start of the Armco barrier. Proceed to the slip road onto the southbound A3 towards Petersfield.

Proceed along A3 towards the Ham Barn Roundabout and take the second exit (1.55 miles). **Continue on A3** until the Liss turning (half a mile past the lay-by, B3006); turn in to the slip road, at the roundabout take the second exit, then bear right following signs for A3 Guildford. Go over the flyover to re-join A3 (3.6 miles) and proceed north.

Continue along A3 to Ham Barn Roundabout, **Approaching Ham Barn Roundabout stay in the middle lane** & take 2nd Exit and continue north on the A3 (5.2 miles). Proceed north passing turnings for the (1) A325 (Farnham) (2) Griggs Green, at the third turning (10.3 miles) take the left turn signposted Haslemere / Liphook, and continue over the flyover taking the left turn onto the slip road to rejoin the A3 in a southerly direction (signposted Petersfield / Portsmouth).

Retrace along A3 towards the Ham Barn Roundabout (passing the START 14.08 miles to start second lap). At the Roundabout take the second exit as before (still on the A3). Once again take the Liss Slip Road & then go directly over roundabout bearing right following sign A3 Guildford. Go over the flyover to re-join A3 (as before).

Re-join A3 as before and retrace outward route up the A3 via Ham Barn Roundabout (19.3 miles) to the Liphook flyover and back down A3. Retrace on A3 to Ham Barn RAB. Take 1st exit on to B3006 (signposted Liss) to:

FINISH on B3006, 20 yards south of a BT cover in Tarmac on opposite side of the road and 40 yards north of Liss sign.

Do not park near the start on the verges, entrance to the ranges, or the depot as this is MOD land, and it is likely that you will be clamped or worse, as well as a DQ! Also, any controlled explosion can unsettle other riders.

The preferred and safe route to the start: To ride to the Start: Turn left upon leaving the HQ and follow the arrows, allow at least 12 minutes getting to the Start. There is no need to go back & forth to the start as we do not move it once the event has started.

The preferred and safe route back to the HQ: After the finish retrace to Ham Barn roundabout and take the second exit (CARE), proceed back along the B3006 to return to HQ.

Procedure During the Event:

Please use a rear and front light & switch in on

If caught, ease back; do not take pace on the wheel of the rider who caught you

If passing a rider please make sure the effort is enough to pass completely

Look where you are going, keep your head up & please don't hog the carriageway, **keep to the inside lane at all times.**
