COVID-19 CTT INSTRUCTIONS

Do not attend if you/your family members have symptoms and/or feel unwell

Although the Covid-19 Protocols have been dropped cases are on the rise so please show courtesy to fellow riders & crew i.e. be considerate with any affectionate greetings. Please be sensible about social distancing, we will keep the doors open at the HQ to allow circulation of fresh air.

There will be no pusher-offered; you will have to do a standing start on your own (one foot on the ground). Rolling starts will not be permitted.

Once you have finished your race you will be asked to return your number & sign out, back at the HQ. Please stay for a quick prize giving which will take place shortly after the last rider has finished (and returned their number!).

Parking

There is a free car park opposite the Village Hall. Please be aware HQ is in a residential area and many will (sensibly!) still be in their beds, so please keep the noise levels down **and no turbos are allowed either in the car park or in the vicinity of any houses if you park elsewhere before 07.00.**

Do not park near the start on the verges. If you park anywhere other than the car park in Liss Village Hall please be considerate towards any residents nearby and do not park in the entrances to fields, on privately owned land etc.

Warming up

Please no warming up on turbos where you will disturb local residents before 07.00. Farnham Road is a good place to warm up.

Route to the start

Turn right out of the Liss Village Car Park then next right into Andlers Ash Road. Continue along along Andlers Ash Road, over a level crossing, until you reach a T junction. The start area is on your left. Please be aware of other road users when you cross the road to the start and when waiting to start please don't block the road.

Route back from the finish

Once you cross the finish keep moving and DO NOT turn around and ride across Ham Barn RAB but continue on Farnham Road then take the first right towards Greatham Village then the next right (next to the church) onto Forest Road. Continue on Forest Road which then turns into Mill Road and brings to you a RAB in Liss. Turn left onto Hill Brow Road and HQ is on your left.

Refreshments: There will be refreshments and home made cakes at HQ.

Course Description P881L/50

Lap 1: Start on Farnham Road at the junction with the Princes Bridge Interchange. Turn left onto the Interchange and which goes over the A3 and proceed down the sliproad to the northbound carriageway of the A3.

Continue along A3 to Ham Barn roundabout keeping in the middle lane. Take the 2nd exit continuing north on the A3. Continue past exits to: Farnham Bordon A325; Griggs Green and past Liphook Services then take the next exit signposted Liphook/Haslemere B2131 (6 miles).

Follow the slip road over the flyover (over the A3) taking the left turn onto the slip road to rejoin the A3 in a southerly direction (signposted Petersfield/Portsmouth). Continue past Liphook Service station, Griggs Green exit and Longmoor interchange to Ham Barn roundabout and take the second exit to continue on the A3 southbound.

Continue on A3 past exits to Liss B3006; Petersfield, Midhurst A272; Winchester A272 Alton A32, and continue to the exit signposted Buriton (18.8 miles). Take this exit, follow the sliproad to the roundabout and take the first exit to go under the A3 up the sliproad on the other side to the northbound carriageway heading towards Guildford. Continue northbound on the A3 passing exits for Winchester A272 Alton A32; Midhurst A272; Petersfield and Liss B3006. *You have now completed lap 1.*

Lap 2: Repeat Lap 1 by continuing north to the Liphook/Haslemere B2131 exit (31.1 miles), then south to the Buriton exit (43 miles). When you pass the turning to Liss B3006 (*end of Lap 2*) continue north towards Ham Barn roundabout. When approaching Ham Barn roundabout keep in left hand lane. Take the 1st exit from Ham Barn roundabout and

FINISH on B3006 Farnham Road, at lamp post no 3 just before the entrance to Ham Barn Business Park (50 miles).

Please DO NOT pull into the entrance of Ham Barn Business Park or stop near the finish.

Procedure During the Event:

- Please use a rear and front light & switch them on
- If caught, ease back; do not take pace on the wheel of the rider who caught you
- If passing a rider please make sure the effort is enough to pass completely
- Look where you are going, keep your head up & please don't hog the carriageway, **keep to the inside lane at all times**. We will have people out spotting riders with their heads down.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. It is also compulsory that WORKING FRONT & REAR LIGHTS, either flashing or constant, are fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use

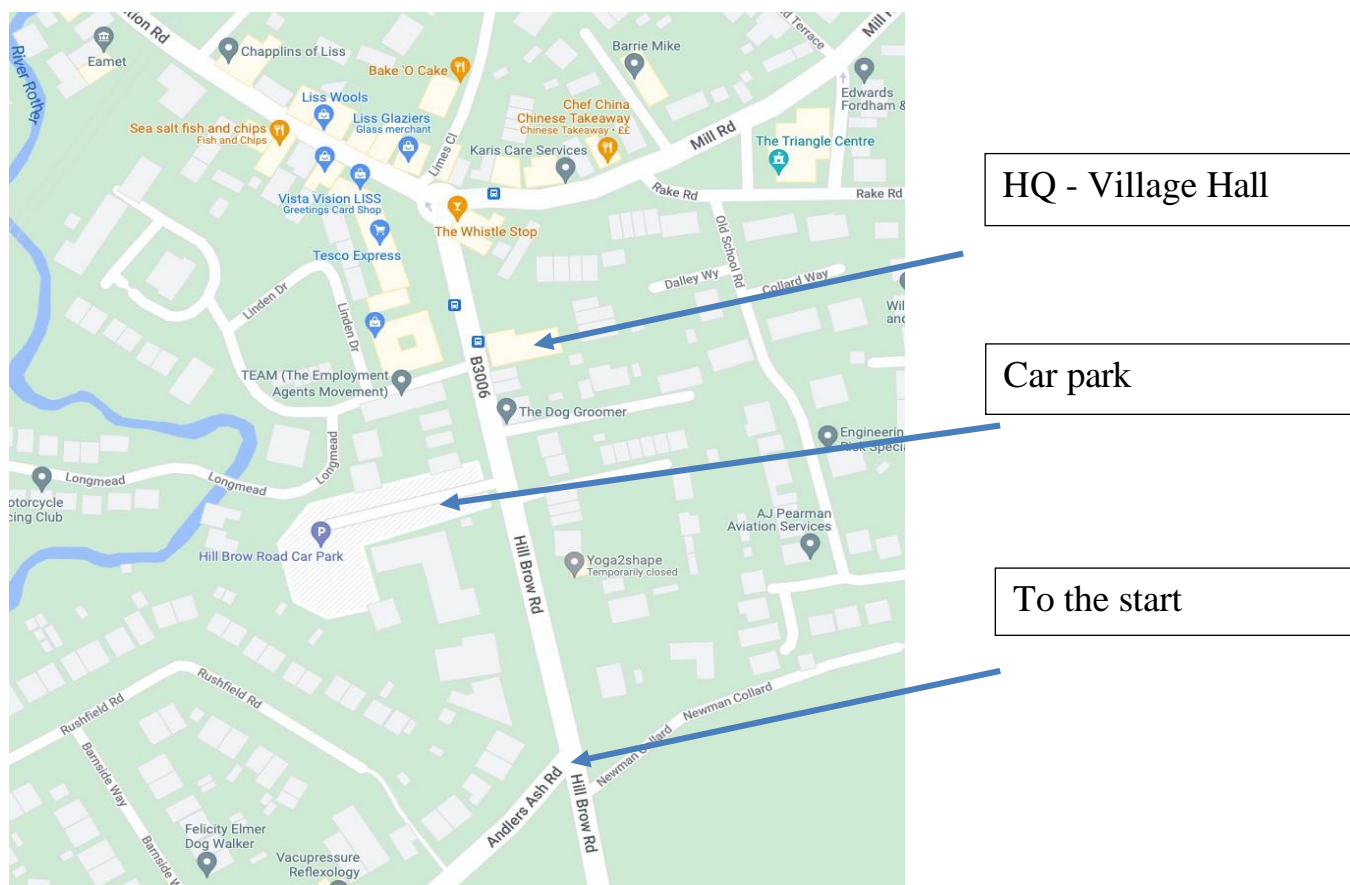
