Competitors' Machine

A working rear light, either flashing or constant, must be fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use. NO LIGHT NO RIDE.

Safety instructions.

CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

As guests of St John's School please do not do anything that could jeopardise the future use of this venue.

Headquarters will be open from 5.45am The Car park MUST be clear by 9.45am

Competitors times will not be available at the conclusion of the event but will be available from 6.00pm on https://southeasternroadclub.webs.com/events-2020

Please be aware that the following information may be amended at short notice. Please familiarise yourself with the following <u>https://cyclingtimetrials.org.uk/documents/index/covid-19</u>

- Competitors should not attend if they feel ill in ANY way or if family members have any symptoms.
- Only car parking and toilet facilities are available at the HQ.
- DO not change in the toilets
- Competitors should not arrive at the HQ more than 40 minutes before their allotted start time.
- Competitors must respect the 2mt social distancing requirement.
- Competitors should not arrive at the start more than 4 mins before their allotted start time.
- Competitors will await the start signal with one foot on the ground.
- Competitors on finishing MUST NOT stop at the finish
- Competitors must not congregate in the car park after the event but disperse promptlyyour car space may well be needed.
- Static warm-ups are allowed but must comply with social distancing requirements that are in place at the time. For those preferring to warm up on the road *see separate details*.
- No support can be provided if a competitor suffers mechanical difficulties. It is strongly advised that all competitors carry with them a spare inner-tube/tubular, pump and tyre levers if required.
- It is strongly advised that all competitors carry a mobile phone and take with them the telephone number of the event organiser. Please telephone the organiser if you have failed to finish the event.

- Hand sanitizer will be available.
- No provision will be provided to return any clothing left at the start back to the HQ .

Riders warm up.

CTT have just announced that turbo trainers can be used for warming up at event HQ's.

For those riders that prefer to warm up on the road there are a couple of options available that do not use any part of the course.

From the HQ proceed to the South Holmwood RBT second exit to Spook Hill follow road to Inholms Lane turn left 800mts, go past St Johns Church and Inholms Lane NT car park to T junction where if you turn left into Chard Lane South where you will eventually rejoin the A24 and turn left back to S Holmwood RBT. About 4kms.total.

If you turn right along Blackbrook Road then just keep going until you have had enough and come back. Please be aware that Inholms Lane has an up each way (which will definitely get the ticker going).

Car parking

For those not familiar with the area there are several free NT woodland car parks that are within a ride able distance of the HQ two are situated in Mill Road and one in Inholms Lane, uphill of the church. None of the CP's has a metalled surface.

If the Mill Road CP's are used do NOT proceed to the HQ via the A24 go to Blackbrook Road and turn left, and at Inholms Lane turn left (entrance to this road has two power poles and a nice big white house and a high green hedge) follow to Spook Hill turn left to start or right to the HQ second exit at South Holmwood RBT turn right into Goodwyns Road. About 5km.

All the above can be viewed on Google street view and no doubt the ubiquitous Garmin.
