Signing on and numbers will be available from 1300h and please arrive a maximum of one hour prior to your start time. **Remember to sign back in when finished**, as per CTT Regulation 17(b) but please do not gather in groups near the sign on. We must vacate the Hall by 1800h. There is ample parking on the Recreation Ground adjacent to the Hall. Please leave the parking in front of the Hall for the Event Crew. No parking allowed anywhere on the course. Please drive dead slow within the parking area.

Whilst the threat from Covid 19 has greatly receded we expect all riders to adhere to the following on the day of the event:

Minimise gatherings – please regardless of your own views on the risk or the rules help us ensure we do not cause any upset to local residents who may remain very sensitive. We want to be able to use the course again without objections from the local Parish council. The hall won't be generally available unless to use the WC. There are no changing facilities so in the interests of decency please consider clothing prior to arrival. Some of the event crew and competitors have yet to be vaccinated even if you have so please be considerate.

Keep the number of riders congregated at the start line to a minimum. Disposable numbers will be provided please take with you and dispose of as appropriate.

#### **Please bring own pins and a pen for sign on and sign in**

Maintain at least one metre from race officials

There will be no pusher off. Riders will need to push themselves off

#### Course details F14/25

START: on the Wrestlingworth-Guilden Morden road approx 540 yds south of Wrestlingworth x-rds and 460 yds north of Common Farm. Proceed south to Guilden Morden where turn LEFT (M) 1.95 miles (2nd circuit 13.73 miles) into New Road leading to Shingay cum Wendy and Wendy to T junction 6.34 miles (2nd circuit 18.12 miles) with A1198. At junction bear LEFT (CAUTION) (M) to roundabout, where bear LEFT (M) onto B1042 to Tadlow and cross roads at Wrestlingworth where bear LEFT (M) 11.48 miles (2nd circuit 23.26 miles) on unclassified road to Guilden Morden and pass start – Repeat circuit and pass start again and in approx 1.5 miles to:

FINISH at south of farm entrance, 50 yds south of Water Hydrant sign and 72 yds north of Bend sign and 149 yds north of large 30 sign. (25 miles)

At various junctions around the course you will be joining a road with traffic priority, therefore please take care and give way. You are reminded to ride on the Left Hand Side of the road except for safe overtaking, in accordance with CTT Regulation 20. Please take special care of this at the Guilden Morden and Wrestlingworth junctions. Riders observed to be not complying with this regulation are subject to disqualification from the event. Marshals will be on the course, which will be signed. However, the onus is on you to negotiate the course correctly and safely.

#### SAFETY NOTICE

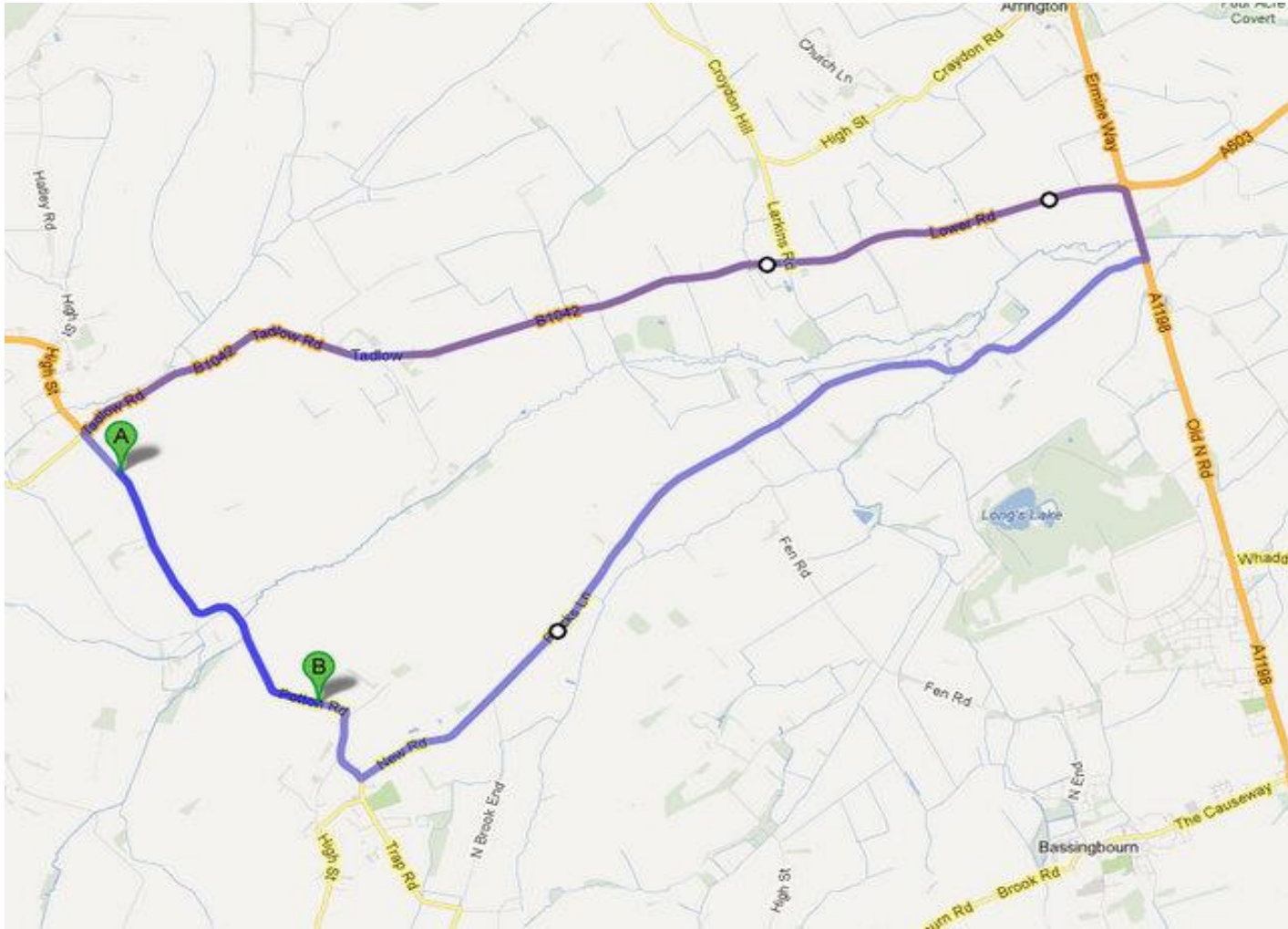
In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoter strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell Helmet that meets an internationally accepted standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 **ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets**. It is mandatory that a working rear light is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users.
