Thank you for entering the 2021 edition of Banbury Star Cyclists' Club Open 10 time trial.

Welcome to this challenging late season event. For hopefully the last time, we will still have to be careful due to the C word, so please take care at the signing-on area not to gather in groups. We will not be supplying catering by our trusty bakers as we would usually like to do, but we will have Paddy from Buzzy Beans on site to provide his refreshments service. As entry fees are unchanged, we are offering some interesting prizes instead.

Results will be published as soon after the race as possible, and should also be made available at the sign on and out area.

You must have a working and visible rear light fitted or you will not be permitted to start. Banbury Star strongly recommends fitting a flashing front light too.

You must sign out and return your number or you will be registered as a DNF.

1. The competition

The race is a 10 mile individual Open time trial run to CTT rules and regulations on the K4/10W course.

2. Event HQ location

We will be using Wroxton Sports Club which is located at Horley Road, Wroxton, Banbury, OX15 6PY. The HQ car park will be open from 0700 onwards. When arriving please follow the guidance of the marshals to carefully park on the club's pitches or in the car park if there is space.

Please note the changing rooms and showers will not be available to competitors so please arrive dressed to ride.

The HQ is approximately 4 miles away from the start line if you take the route via Horley to get there, or 5 miles if you go through the north of Banbury via Drayton. It is also a draggy incline on the main road to the start. Please familiarise yourself with the route and the distance and allow enough time to not miss your start.

Once you have raced, please pack up and leave the event as soon as possible so as to free up parking spaces for later starters.

4. Sign-on and number collection

Each competitor will be required to sign the entry form at both number collection and at the end of their ride when returning the race number. Please bring your own pen to do this.

The race numbers and pins will be sterilised before and after the event.

Any additional risks or course information will be communicated to you at number collection.

It is essential that social distancing is maintained at the HQ at all times, You must keep a 2m distance in all directions from all other competitors and officials.

5. The Start

Here is a Garmin map showing the route to take from the race HQ to the start line:

The start line is on the B4100 Warwick Road 200m north of the Camper King garage at Warmington and will be marked with Banbury Star flags. There is no car parking available at the start line or surrounding area. Carpenters Farm Shop may be open on the day. Please do not block the entry and exit or the sightlines from there.

No pre-race warm up on the B4100 after the start line in the direction of the race is allowed. This is to avoid overtaking/being overtaken and confusing the timekeepers. Competitors are advised to use the B4100 towards Banbury to warm up.

A maximum of only **four** competitors will be allowed at the starting area at any one time: the rider who is about to start and their three following competitors.

It is the responsibility of all entrants to accurately time their arrival at the start area to avoid group gatherings and congestion.

There will be no pusher-offer at the start line, riders will start from a stationary standing position with one foot on the ground on instruction from the Time Keeper. A rolling start is not allowed.

6. The Course

Shortly after starting, competitors begin the descent of the 14% hill where speeds of 50mph are not uncommon.

At the bottom of the hill a draggy 1% incline is encountered which after one mile delivers the riders to the top of the second descent, this time the 10% hill speeding competitors past MOD Kinton where there is a new roundabout and then onwards for another two miles until the turning point at the Gaydon roundabout is made.

Take the 4th exit and accelerate back down the slope retracing your route heading towards Banbury. The speed builds quickly and before you know it you'll be at the foot of the 10% hill. On cresting it you'll soon be on the home straight and cross the finish line at the foot of Warmington Hill.

And breathe...BUT DO NOT STOP OR YOU WILL BE DQd.

7. The Finish

The finish line is located at Warmington Hill Garage. No spectators, family members or competitors are allowed to gather at the finish.

On crossing the finish line please shout your race number to help the Time Keeper record your time and then continue on the B4100 to return to the race HQ to sign back in and place your race number.
