## The Willie Rafferty Memorial Trophy

### List of Awards

One rider one prize. Fastest overall rider (TT or Road) gets the trophy irrespective of gender or age. Trophies are in order of priority, e.g. if you are the fastest Vet 50 who wins overall on a road bike then you get the 1<sup>st</sup> Overall Prize only. This means prizes are more distributed amongst competitors.

**NB** For those awards where a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize are listed: there must be at least one entrant in a gender or bike category for 1<sup>st</sup> prize to be offered, three entrants for a first and second prize and 5 entrants for a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> prize to be offered. Monies will be evenly distributed to other prizes.

## Brief History of St Christophers Cycling Club and The Trophy

ST CHRISTOPHERS IS A WELCOMING CLUB FOR CYCLISTS OF ALL AGES AND ABILITIES

Members ride socially and competitively. Regardless if you are a novice cyclist wishing to improve or an experienced racer you'll find St Christophers a welcoming club.

"Glasgow St. Christopher's Wheelers" was formed on the 14th April 1935 at the Bellevue Nursery. Following an advertisement in the "Irish Weekly" some twenty interested persons attended the first meeting.

Founder members included Willie Rafferty, Willie Fox. Jack Dougherty and Michael Gallagher who died whilst touring Ireland. In 1982 the name was changed and St. Christophers Cycling Club continues based in East Kilbride.



The club now have around 30 active members and regularly organise Social Rides on Thursday Nights and Sundays as well as hosting the 10m TT Jack Robertson Auldhouse League on a Tuesday. The club normally run 2 Open events annually via the CTT

# The Course

## Event HQ

**Event HQ:** Bishopton Community Hall, Gledstane Rd, Bishopton, PA7 5AU

**Event Sign-On:** from 7:00 am

**Event Organiser:** Vincent Pickering

### Notes for Competitors

1. Sign on will be open from 7:00 am in the Bishopton Hall
2. Please read the enclosed anti-doping notice.
3. Under 18s must complete a parental consent form (this can be downloaded from the CTT site) and hand it in at sign on. No form = No ride.
4. The distance from Race HQ is approximately 2.5 miles, heading West – please allow plenty of time to reach the start area before your allocated time.
5. Course Marshals have no legal authority to stop traffic on the course, and as such will only provide course directional information.
6. Limited shower facilities are available at Race HQ, beyond the kitchen area - although these may be seconded for any anti-doping controls.
7. All presentation awards will be at the end of the event.
8. Once a rider has completed their ride, they must return their race number and sign out, failure to do either will result in a DNF
9. Riders MUST have both FRONT and REAR lights affixed to their bike, both must be visible and working.
10. Riders MUST not wear dark coloured clothing.
11. Riders MUST not ride with their head down at any point
12. Riders MUST ensure their bicycle is mechanically fit-for-purpose (steering; brakes; drive-train; contact points etc).
13. Riders MUST NOT change lanes at any point on the course except where maneuvering safely into the outside lane for the Newark Castle turn roundabout. Any crossing of the central white line will be an automatic disqualification.
14. Riders MUST adhere to the rules and regulations of the Highway. Marshals and Police will be monitoring riding standards. 16. Any rider that is reported for breach of any of the above WILL incur sanctions - this may include disqualification.

## Doping Control

**This event may be subject to a Doping Control It is your responsibility to check.**

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control.

Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby.

Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.



## Course Details

Course Details: Westferry WW10/01

See Map below

1. Race HQ is in the Bishopton Community Hall: The distance from Race HQ is approximately 2.5miles, heading West – please allow plenty of time to reach the start area before your allocated time.
2. Start under railway bridge on Greenock Rd heading West... approx. 2.5miles from RaceHQ
3. Immediate LEFT on slip-road to A8 at Westferry roundabout...
4. Proceed westbound on A8...
5. Straight through first roundabout at Langbank....
6. Take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit at second roundabout at Woodhall...
7. Continue on A8 to TURN at Newark Roundabout... PLEASE OBSERVE EXTREME CAUTION.
8. Retrace to finish at slip-road to Westferry roundabout.
