SIGN ON

It is compulsory for all riders to **sign on AND sign out**. Numbers will be available at the event headquarters at Hungerford Cricket Club which will be open from 12:00 noon.

There are toilet and changing facilities at the HQ please park considerately

ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE A WORKING FRONT AND REAR LIGHT AND A HARDSHELL HELMET – NO LIGHTS, NO HELMET NO RIDE

TO THE START

It is approximately 2.5 miles from the HQ to the start so please allow sufficient time. I have provided two routes with strava links – one is via the town centre (this will be signposted) and the other is via Hungerford Common (this will not be signposted) – if you are going to use the route via Hungerford Common please take extra care when crossing the A4. Please allow sufficient time to reach the start.

Routes from HQ to start and back to the HQ (see maps and strava links below).

If you would like to park closer to the start you may be able to find spaces on the road through the Charnham Industrial Estate (see map below) you may also warm up on the B4192

ROAD BIKE REGULATIONS

(a) The road bike can possess drop or straight handlebars; no tri-bars, clip-on bars or Spinaci bars are allowed; no disc wheels; both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each; the maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm.

(b) Helmets used in Road Bike category events must not cover the ears or have a tear drop/pointy style "tail", any helmet vents must not be covered or blocked. The helmet must not have been altered or had any element added or removed in terms of design or form but may be used as the manufacturer intended (e.g., sliding vents). It is prohibited to add a detachable cover to a helmet. The composition of the helmet material and its surface condition are not subject to any regulations. However, additions to the helmet are not allowed (cover, tape etc.).

N.B. For competitors riding Road Bikes, competitors must predominantly ride holding the drops or brake hoods. Riders may not ride in the "Puppy Paws" Position or simulate a Tri-Bar position by resting the forearms on the handlebars

AWARDS/PRIZES

Awards are made to VTTA members only.

VTTA Gold Medal – best on standard – men and women VTTA Silver Medal – 2^{nd} on standard – men and women VTTA Bronze Medal – 3^{rd} on standard – men and women

- VTTA Gold Medal fastest man and woman on actual time
- VTTA Gold Medal fastest man or woman on actual time on a road bike
- VTTA Gold Medal fastest tandem on standard
- VTTA Gold Medal fastest team of 3 on standard

Winners of the Gold Medal on standard will receive and invitation to the L&HC Annual Prizegiving Lunch

Results will be available after the event via resultsheet or using the barcode located at the HQ.


NOTES TO RIDERS

Please make sure you read the following

.1	Competitors should not attend if they feel ill in ANY way.
2	No riding with your head down, any rider observed riding dangerously will be disqualified from the event and reported to the CTT District Committee for further disciplinary action. Have a fast, but safe ride. Always give priority to traffic from your right when negotiating roundabouts.
3	NO 'U' TURNS are allowed within sight of either the start or finish area. Riders carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre are liable for disqualification from the event and further disciplinary action by the CTT District Committee.

	No parking at either the start or the finish by any rider					
4	No warming-up by competitors is allowed along any part of the designated course, after the event has started.					
5	Riders are reminded that dropping litter (such as energy gel wrappers) is a criminal offence and offenders will be liable to disciplinary action by the District Committee.					
6	Riders are required to both sign on and sign off. Failure to sign off will result in a rider being marked as DNF.					
7	When finishing, please do not return to the finishing area or communicate with the timekeepers					
8	Riders are reminded that no competitor shall be allowed to start an event unless they are wearing a HARD SHELL SAFETY HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.					
9	Riders are also reminded that no competitor shall be allowed to start an event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light and affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light; lights to be illuminated, either flashing or constant, and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.					

COURSE MAP AND DETAILS




START on A4 approximately 2 miles east of Hungerford, and 258 yards east of entrance to former Norland College and 8 yards east of the eastern field gate post, SU366684.

Proceed east on A4 to first roundabout at the junction of A4 and B4000 - 5.3 miles Circle roundabout passing the 1st exit to B4000, the 2nd exit to A34 and the 3rd exit A4 (Newbury). Take 4th exit and retrace west on A4

FINISH at 7 yards after "P" sign at layby on south side of road 0.6 miles east of start at SU371684, approximately 50 yards west of junction with Radley Bottom road where finish 10.000 miles.




