

COURSE V212:

START approx 3.5 miles south of Boroughbridge in entrance to A168 from old A1 (now a long lay-by) at a point approx 1 yard before "Clearway" sign. **TURN LEFT** on to A168 and proceed to Walshford roundabout (4.72 miles). **ENCIRCLE** roundabout and retrace along A168 to Arkendale Road, to **FINISH** adjacent to central bollard at a blue paint mark. (10.00 mls).

The A168 is a Clearway – NO PARKING – NO U-TURNS.

Please note that marshals are only to indicate your direction, and not to control traffic in your favour. At each junction it is your responsibility to ensure that it is safe to proceed. Keep your heads up, and keep to the left of the carriageway.

There is currently a 40mph speed restriction through the roadworks area near the A59 fly-over. It is unlikely that there will be any works taking place at the A59 junction during the event. If there are any roadworks, look out for slow moving vehicles crossing the A168 carriageway to/from their compound between the A168 and the A1(M).

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, CYCLING TIME TRIALS, AND THE EVENT PROMOTERS, STRONGLY ADVISE YOU TO WEAR A HARD SHELL HELMET WHICH MEETS AN INTERNATIONALLY ACCEPTED SAFETY STANDARD.

NB: HARD SHELL HELMET COMPULSORY FOR RIDERS AGED UNDER 18 YEARS & JUNIORS.

It is compulsory that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users, and is active whilst the machine is in use.

EVENT HQ

HEADQUARTERS and PARKING –

Rabbit Hill is on east side of A168, about 1 mile north of Allerton Park Waste Disposal Plant.

On entering site, parking is on your right, Café is to your left. Numbers and signing-on/signing-out will be located here (outdoors). There are toilets available, but no changing facilities. Please read updated CTT Covid-19 Risk Assessment (on CTT site). Although lockdown rules have eased, please be aware that some riders/helpers may wish to continue to follow previous rules – face coverings/distancing etc, own pens/pins, so do allow them sufficient space. Café may still require face-coverings to enter. Please do not gather in groups at the start.

Don't forget to return number and SIGN OUT after your ride – REG. 17(b). Failure to do so will result in rider being recorded as a DNF.

On returning your bib number, you will receive a voucher for a free tea/coffee in the Café.

Anything else must be purchased at your cost.

Please note that the Café has to close at 16:00 today, so later starters please return your number/sign-out and collect your drink as soon as possible.

There is no parking available near the start, or at the finish, except for Officials.

Do not park in the long-lay on the east side of the A168, adjacent to the start, it is now private property. There are other lay-bys/parking spaces on the A168, but the lay-by on west side of road, south of the A59 flyover is currently closed in connection with the works on the motorway.
