COVID-19 CTT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Do not attend if you/your family members feel ill.
- 2) Park and walk with social distancing in mind. Bring and use a face mask.
- 3) HQ open for sign on and out. Toilets are 1 in, 1 out.
- 4) Bring your own pen to sign on and, if you need them to affix your number, your own safety pins.
- 5) No changing facilities are available at the HQ before or after racing; attend dressed to race.
- 6) Take with you when you race a compulsory rear light, a spare tyre/tube/tub and a mobile phone.
- 7) Please note you have to make your own way back in event of trouble – no collections offered. Please ring event secy. if you are a DNF.
- 8) No more than 5 riders, 2m apart, to wait at the start.
- 9) No items/clothing to be left at the start or with the timekeeper and no push-off.
- 10) After racing, please sign out with your own pen and leave your number in the bowl at the HQ.
- 11) Please leave the car parking area in a timely and quiet fashion.

Parking – Please use the free car park virtually opposite the HQ. Be aware this is a residential area so please keep the noise levels down, no noisy turbo's please.

Under no circumstances must you use the car park at Greatham Village Hall, or the surrounding roads, especially near the church.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. It is also compulsory that a WORKING LIGHT, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use

The preferred and safe route to the start: Turn right upon leaving the HQ and take the second exit at the mini roundabout, Station Rd proceed on this road through Liss Forest and onto Greatham, approx. 2/3 miles. Turn left at the T junction and take first exit at mini roundabout to head to the start. Allow at least 25 minutes getting to the start as the railway crossing may be down. Signage will be in place for you to follow.

The preferred and safe route back to the HQ; After the finish proceed to Ham Barn roundabout and take the first exit, proceed along the B3006 and bear left on Station Rd to Liss Village, cross the railway crossing and take second exit at mini roundabout to return to HQ and car park.

Procedure During the Event:

Please use a rear light & switch in on

If caught, ease back; do not take pace on the wheel of the rider who caught you

If passing a rider please make sure the effort is enough to pass completely

Look where you are going, keep your head up & please don't hog the carriageway, **keep to the inside lane at all times.**


Course Description P881/10 # Below ~↓

Course Details 10 Mile TT ~ Greatham – West Liss / Liphook A3 ~ P881/10 mile

Start on the B3006 off the A3 Liss/Selborne turning 190 yards from the Ham Barn roundabout at a point 17 yards west of centre of three concrete manhole covers on the tarmac footpath.

Proceed to the roundabout and take the first exit on to the A3 signposted Guildford London. Proceed north passing turnings for the (1) A325 (Farnham) (2) Griggs Green, at the third turning (5.2 miles) take the left turn signposted Haslemere-Liphook, and continue over the flyover taking the left turn onto the slip road to rejoin the A3 in a southerly direction (signposted Petersfield – Portsmouth).

Retrace along A3 towards the Ham Barn Roundabout to finish at the third marker on the lay-by approximately 600 yards north of Ham Barn roundabout (10 miles).
